Rules:

Grain & Seed Crops:

Leave husks on all corn classes except shelled.

HAY:

Long Hay only - an exhibit shall consist of a bale section at least 8 inches thick, or an equivalent amount if cut from hay in the mow
A Grand Champion ribbon will be awarded for Hay

Hay Class notes:

- 01 - Alfalfa or alfalfa grass mixed - later cutting. Not over 50% grasses
- 02 - Grass - first cutting. Mixtures of timothy and/or other grasses and containing not more than 10% legumes
- 03 - Grass -second cutting. Mixtures of timothy and/or other grasses and containing not more than 10% legumes
- 04 - Mixed hay - any mixture not classified in previous categories but which contains 50% or more singly or in combination of alfalfa, timothy, clover and grasses
- 05 - Summer annual grasses - Sudan grass sorghum (Sudan, hybrids, etc.)

STRAW:

Long Straw only – an exhibit shall consist of a bale section at least 8 inches thick, or an equivalent amount
