ROCKFORD MODEL T CLUB MEETING MINUTES, DEC 2,2020

President Steve Kindell welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order via teleconference. Officers and members present included; Steve Kindell, Wayne Henson, Duane Bunton, Deb Werner, Bill Werner, Kurt Duesterhoeft, Gene Clifton, Dean Wanfalt, Craig Sheridan, Dave Lantz, Tim Wanfalt, Wayne Orrison, Cathy Bunton and Yvonne Wilson.

Minutes: Deb Werner read the minutes from the clubs November meeting. Dean Wanfalt moved to approve, seconded by Wayne Henson.

Old Business: no Old Business at this time.

New Business: Steve Kindell asked if anyone is interested in running for the office of the clubs Vice President. No one spoke up so Steve said the club will proceed without a Vice President. Steve asked if the current officers would continue on in their present positions since we did not have any volunteers for office for an election and Duane Bunton stated he will continue as the club Treasure, Deb Werner stated she will continue as the club Secretary, and Bill Werner, Dave Lantz and Kurt Duesterhoeft said they will continue as Board Members.

Little Hershey: Dave Lantz said he received a call from Boone County Fairgrounds, asking if the club would be interested in trading our usual space with the Urban Farm-girl, in exchange for the cost of the rent for our event. Dave said the proposed space is the southeast corner of the fairgrounds, by the racetrack. dave said the proposed space would include vendors arriving through Gate 4 and the public arriving through Gate 5 via McKinley Ave. The Pony Arena is included along with covered spaces. Dave said he will tour the area Monday

afternoon at 3:00 PM. Other club members expressed interest in touring the space on Monday too, then decide the final decision on Monday at 7:00 PM via a teleconference.

Future Club Events: no Christmas Party is planned for this year due to the pandemic. Wayne Henson said he will host the New Years Day tour and asked the club members to contact him and leave a message stating they would like to go on tour. Wayne said the tour will include northwest Rockford and Belvidere areas.

Non-Club Events: Dave said the Steels and Deals car show went on Nov. 8th at the Rockford Speedway was a small show, but a good display of cars and the good weather helped with the attendance. Dave said approximately 10 to 15 triages were awarded. Bill Werner said he attended the swap meet event on Nov. 7th and said that while the swap meet was small, it was a nice show. Dave and Bill said they are hoping Steals and Deals will be scheduled for 2021.

Illnesses: Duane said he called Mary Sheley who is home from the hospital and is feeling better, but is still experiencing elevated blood pressure and said she may have suffered a ministoke, but has no lasting effects. Duane said he also called Betty Clifton who said she will be given an epidural injection on Dec 21st for her back pain issues.

LITTLE HERSHEY FOLLOWUP

The club had a teleconference meeting at 7:00 PM on Dec.10th to discuss the findings from the questions from the teleconference meeting Dec. 2 that Dave Lantz had for the Boone County Fairgrounds regarding the proposed space swap with Farm-girls.

Attending the teleconference were: Steve Kindell, Wayne Henson, Duane Bunton, Deb Werner, Bill Werner, Kurt Duesterhoeft, Gene Clifton, Dean Wanfalt, Craig Sheridan, Dave Lantz, Tim Wanfalt, Wayne Orrison, Bill Werner, Cathy Bunton and Yvonne Wilson.

Questions were:

- #1- (Terms of the swap?) I want to be sure I understand your question about choice of location. If you are wanting to know, if you decide to move to the new location, will we offer you the opportunity to move back to the front, should Main Street Market stop hosting their events here, at some point in the future the answer is **yes**, and you would again be responsible for payment. If you are asking to have that choice each year the answer is **no**. Once the move is made, it is made, until Main Street leaves.
- #2- (Are buildings #3 & #4 included?) **Yes**, the Poultry and Goat Barns will be included.
 - #3- (What about Port-A-Johns?) Yes, 6 Port-a-Johns will be included.
- #4- (Are the Ticket Booths at Gates 3 and 4 included?) Yes, the Ticket Buildings used would be included.

- #5- (Is there handicap parking?) **Yes**, Keith and the Grounds Crew will set up a handicapped parking area, either near Gate 3 or 4.
- #6- (Will we be required to have 3 exits?) **No**, You will not be required to have 3 exits. I am sure that was due to the size of her crowd.
- #7- (Can we jointly use Gate 2?) **No**, You will not be able to use Gate 2 for your vendor entrance. You will need to use Gate 3 as your "Main Gate", and Gate 4 as your vendor entrance. Or, consider having your vendors come in at Gate 5.
- #8- (Can we mark the floor in the barns?) **Yes**, You can spray paint, or chalk, your vendor spaces in the indoor buildings, just be wary of the walls. We do not supply paint or chalk.
- #9, (What about the animal smell/odors in the barns?) **No**, there should be no concern about animal smells. The last event held in those buildings, with animals, is the fair. There will be lots of time between August and May to air out.

Dave also reported on his survey questioning of a sample number of long term veteran vendors currently registered vendors (left over from last years cancelled Little Hershey who elected to keep their registration and fees active for this years show) to gage their response to potentially moving to a new location. All five long time vendors responded and all were positive about such a move.

A vote was taken by the members present on the teleconference regarding approval of the proposed space swap. It was a unanimous yes.

There are still some questions regarding future space payments and additional fees that Dave will clarify with the Boone County Fairgrounds. However, the opportunity to communicate with the staff at the fairgrounds is limited to a couple of times per week in the off-season. Therefore, we will have another teleconference on Monday, Dec. 21st at 7:00 PM. ALL CLUB MEMBERS ARE INVITED AND ENCOURAGED TO ATTEND.

Here is the procedure to call in:

- · Between 6:50 and 7:00 PM, December 21st, 2020, please call 551-258-6834
- You will be asked for your name, which will be announced to the rest of the participants as your call is joined to the group.
- Keep your phone muted while not talking, please

At 7:00 PM I will take a roll call to see who has called in.
