made sure the work completed was done per the ARC submission. The Committee will provide swift review and get back to you in 30 days or less of request. Currently they are

not meeting as a group due to Covid19, but will handle requests via phone and e-mail.

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<u>Awnings</u> have been approved by the Board with guidelines by the ARC committee. If interested, follow the guidelines and submit your request.

<u>Outside safety lights and door cameras</u> have been approved by the Board with guidelines provided by the ARC committee. Please be sure to follow the guidelines to avoid additional cost to fix what was not followed.

House numbers have been approved by the Board. The ARC committee has arranged to have numbers put on the garage doors of the townhomes and single-family homes. They are a certain size by code and placed in a location that can be seen from the road. Anyone who has placed numbers on their garage will be asked to remove them so there is a uniform location of the numbers and placed where fire, medical and police personnel can recognize them quickly. Work will begin Mid-Late April. Watch your email for additional information. Cost will come out of the existing budget.
