

2019 NC Black Elected Municipal Officials Scholarship Guidelines Minimum Eligibility Requirements (Applicants)

Each year the NC Black Elected Municipal Officials, through generous donations, is able to provide scholarships to outstanding students who live in NC and will attend a university/college in the NC System or out of state. The awards are \$1,000.00 for students attending a (four year) college or University and (\$500.00) for students attending a Technical School. It is the duty of our dedicated Scholarship Committee to determine the most outstanding individuals to receive these awards. The NC Black Elected Municipal Officials do not provide financial aid to individuals, only scholarships through this process.

1. Must be a U.S. Citizen and a resident of North Carolina.

2. Applicant must submit an official high school transcript on official school letterhead (school stamped) and or signed, with two letters of recommendations from teachers or other professionals written on their letterhead.

3. Applicant must provide evidence of acceptance/enrollment in a four-year university/college or a two-year college or technical school by providing a copy of an official acceptance letter.

4. Applicant must have a grade point average at or above 3.0 (B)

5. Applicant must provide a list of awards, volunteer and work hours with the year received attached.

6. Applicant must complete the scholarship application with all required documents.
(INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE PROCESSED).
Applicant should be able to transform the PDF document to a word document to complete application.

7. Scholarship application should meet the June 21, 2019 DEADLINE.

8. Applicant is required to be present at the award presentation that takes place at the Annual NCBEMO summer conference.

9. Application and all correspondence should be typed.
