

# Pageant Information: 2021

## “Miss, Jr. Miss and Teen Miss”

**I. Orientation:** You will be notified by Pageant Committee of the time and place of Orientation/Photos you will be given more detailed information along with the Official Rules of this pageant at Orientation.

**II. Note:** Attendance and participation in orientation, all meetings, all practices and all pre-pageant events is mandatory, unless you have extra-curricular activity and director is notified before. Contestants will be awarded one point for each required activity. Awarded points will be calculated into the final score, so be careful to fulfill all requirements.

Pageant Categories:

1. Queen – (Miss Queen \$1000 scholarship), title, crown, sash, flowers, gift bag and trophy

2. 1st Runner-up - \$350 scholarship, sash

3. 2nd Runner-up - \$250 scholarship, sash

4. 3rd Runner-up - \$150 scholarship, sash

**Note:** The newly crowned Queen must first complete her year reign before her scholarship can be awarded. All Scholarship recipients' monies are sent directly to the college/university of choice upon proof of registration.

The following are also awarded in all age categories. (scholarship's for Miss division only)

6. Miss Photogenic – sash, (Miss only \$100.00 scholarship) see photo requirements – selected by judges)

7. Miss Congeniality – sash (Miss only, 100.00 scholarship) (*selected by peers*)

8. Best Costume – sash, (*selected by judges*)

**III. Presentations Practices:** will begin in August –( time and place to be announced)

1. Interview before the judges – August 28, 2021 Jr. and Teen. (MHS. T-shirt and denim Capri's or jeans.)

2. Fiesta – Group opening presentation of contestants.(MHS. T-shirt and denim capri's or jeans.)

3. Fiesta – On-stage introduction in Spanish and English. (MHS. T-shirt and denim capri's or jeans.)

4. Fiesta – On-stage “Formal” presentation (modest and age appropriate and approved by chairman)

5. Fiesta – On-stage “Mexican Costume” presentation. Submit the following in advance:

(a) A 2-paragraph description of the Mexican state and the Mexican costume being presented 1pt

(b) Completed Contestant Bio ( Use MHS outline form) 1pt

(c) on a CD or jump drive that represents that state 1pt

**IV. Judging:**

1. Judges and tabulators will be selected and approved by the Pageant Committee and MHS Board

2. Contestants cannot be related to or have close association with Pageant judges

3. Points awarded for complying with scheduled activities will be calculated in final judging.
