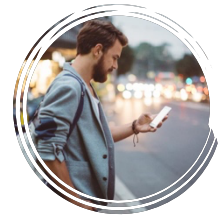


BLESSINGS FOR THE FAITHFUL



Psalm 101:6 King James Version (KJV)

“Mine eyes shall be upon the faithful of the land, that they may dwell with me: he that walketh in a perfect way, he shall serve me.

(Prov 28:20) A faithful man will abound with blessings, But he who hastens to be rich will not go unpunished.

A definition of faithful: loyal, constant, reliable, committed, to whatever one owes allegiance. **faithful** implies unswerving adherence to a person or thing or to the oath or promise by which a tie was contracted.

God blesses faithfulness. People who are loyal, constant, reliable, committed to the work of the Lord.

Psalm 37:28 - “For the LORD loves the just and will not forsake his faithful ones.”
