Should you want to invite them to your home ore a neighborhood PC event that should be done by giving them an invitation to meet other like mined voters and get updates on things going on, but not to support any Candidate, especially prior to the Primary election.

When caring petitions for candidates, please be aware that you and others can only sign one (1) Petition for the following candidates; Governor, Sectary of State, State Treasurer, LD Senator. You can sign two (2) for LD House, Corporation Commissioner. The rule is when there is only one (1) open seat than you sign only one (1) petition. All other petitions are based on the number of open seats for that office. Also, all signatures must be Republicans for Republican Candidates. DO NOT carry petitions for Democrats.
