The library is the second building on the left on the corner of Maxwell Road and Albany Shaker Road but you will need to go around the rotary to enter as there is no left turn allowed. Coming from the **NORTH** take exit 4, where the road splits bear right. At the light at the end of the ramp turn left onto Rt. 155. At the next light turn left onto Albany Shaker Road. Go through the next light and around the rotary and the library is on the right on the corner of Maxwell and Albany Shaker Road.
