

EDWIN LLOYD COLGAN

1907 - 1982

E. Lloyd Colgan, age 75, of Bad Axe, died Tuesday, Sept. 7 at his home following a long illness.

He was born April 12, 1907 in Woodham, Ontario, Canada, son of the late Edwin and Mary (Moutray) Colgan.

He and Juanita (Mac) McKibbin were married Aug. 27, 1949 in Bay City. They owned and operated a mink ranch near Bad Axe and he was a bookkeeper for Thumb Oil and Gas Company until his retirement in 1973. He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Bad Axe, a World War II veteran, and a member of the D.S.V. and a mason.

Surviving are his wife; one sister, Mrs. Henrietta McCurdy, Saginaw; one brother, James F. Colgan, Elkton and several nieces and nephews.
