OPAL meeting minutes

President, Pam Hartford presided over the meeting.

Pam announced changes in the OPAL board members and new chairperson positions adopted by the board at the March 1st board meeting.

- 1st Vice President (formerly Vice President) Nina Hawranick. This position is in charge of the Member Fall Exhibition (locating venue, in charge of take in, hanging, take down and coordinating with the newly created Show Exhibition Chair for prizes, judge, and advertising if warranted.
- Corresponding Secretary. This position will create a monthly OPAL newsletter that includes monthly meeting minutes, newsworthy items from members regarding exhibits, programs, upcoming meetings, etc. Corresponding Secretary will distribute newsletter to members via e-mail and send to the Website Coordinator for posting on OPAL website. Items for the newsletter will be due to the secretary by the 15th of each month and will be distributed by the secretary to members on or before the 1st of each month. This position is being filled by new member Mayme Hausman.
- Recording Secretary (formerly Secretary). This position records minutes for Board Meetings and monthly Member Meetings. Provides minutes to the President for approval, provides approved Board minutes to Board Members and approved meeting minutes to Corresponding Secretary for inclusion in the Newsletter. This position is being filled by Lynn Carty former co-secretary with Diane Ruck.
- 2nd Vice President. Position open as of end of meeting.

New Chair positions:

- **New Member Chair.** Welcomes new members via e-mail and navigates them through the offerings of OPAL. **This position is being filled by Nina Hawranick** as well as her 1st VP duties.
- **Meeting Program Chair.** Determines and books demonstrations, speakers and venue for monthly meetings. **This is being filled by Diane Ruck,** formerly co-secretary.
- Workshop Chair. Contacts regional and national artists for two OPAL workshops per year.
 Workshop has already been scheduled by Diane Ruck for Saturday June 4th via video at a Delaware Co-Hatch location with Jacob Agular. Pertain Gillespie-Buckland was nominated for and accepted this position.
- **Show Exhibition Chair.** Works with the 1st and 2nd Vice Presidents to coordinate Spring and Fall OPAL shows by providing judges, prizes, advertising. Finds venues, advertises as necessary, works with volunteer committee members to help with intake, hanging and pickup, and works with Refreshment Chair, for all other member exhibits. **Bob Sako has accepted this position.**
- Refreshment Chair. Develops and maintains refreshment list to present at meetings for volunteer sign up to bring beverages and snacks to meetings and exhibits. Contacts volunteers

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with reminders prior to meetings via e-mail or phone. Cathy Stoessner has accepted this position.

Other Business:

Venue has already been obtained for 2023 Spring Show at Gallery 22 in Delaware Ohio. OPAL will be there in May and June of 2023.

Venue has already been obtained for 2022 Fall Show at Westerville Community Center. Take in is September 22nd, each participant will bring 2-3 **NEW** pieces. Prizes will be awarded.
