Redistricting 2021

A lot of the members in District 9 have contacted my office regarding the new state redistricting changes and how they effect the current representation of District 9. Until January 18th 2023, the present Representatives and Senators for each district remain the same. The people decide who represent them, not a redistricting committee in Anchorage.

So what has changed? Nothing yet. Today the new districts for the up coming election were changed, and only effect the new geographical district areas for the purpose of the up coming 2022 State Election.

The State recognized Party's will be in the process of ending the existing officers terms of the old geographical district s and prepare transitional elections for the district committee offices of the new geographical districts.

You are all still in District 9 until January of 2023.

I encourage you to look at the new redistricting map to understand your future district geographical grouping and number.
