



Whether or not your home appears as a target for a burglar will largely depend upon what the burglar sees from the outside. They are looking for clues, opportunities, and easy entry. Home security and your first line of defense is the “appearance” that there’s nothing special here... just move along. Put yourself in their shoes and look around your property and home from the street. Do you blend in?

These top three break-in points cover about 80 percent of all home burglary break-ins.

- 1. Most burglars break into homes straight through the front door.**
- 2. The second most likely point of entry for the burglar is through a first floor window.**
- 3. Through the back door**

Although statistically much less likely, a burglar will also gain entry to your home through the garage, the basement, or a second floor window.
