

“Agreement Prayer”

I had planned on posting something else (imagine that!), when I felt strongly to pray for you. Prayer is an act of obedience and God promises to respond when we call to Him. He is all powerful and in control of everything in His creation. As we call upon Him situations change. Prayer is the primary method of communication between God and man.

"For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you and asking God to fill you with the knowledge of His will through all spiritual wisdom and understanding. And we pray this in order that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and may please him in every way"
(Colossians 1:9-10).

Three times in the first ten verses of this letter the Apostle Paul has told the Colossians that he is praying for them. Prayer is a vital part our thinking and our daily lives. Throughout my life, my prayers have been answered very directly many times. Prayer is the greatest blessing for any believer. God’s Word is clear “The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working” (James 5:16).

When we speak and pray the Scriptures, we are coming into agreement with God, and His power is released to answer our prayers.

We thank you, that You promised to guide us into all TRUTH. We thank You, that you promised that Your Spirit of truth would come to us, and that He will not speak on His own, but will only speaks what He hears, and that He will tell us of what is yet to come.

We thank You for Your Spirit of truth that warns, guides, corrects and directs us. We thank You that He will take from what is Yours, and make it known to us because it all belongs to You, and You make it known to us.

We thank You for Your continual protection. We thank You for Your mercy. We thank You for Your love and grace that sustains us daily. We wait in hope for You, Oh Lord. For we know that You are our help, and our shield. That You are the help and shield of those we love. That Your eye is on the sparrow, on us and on our families.

Oh God, our strength, we watch for You; You, O God, are our fortress. You, O God, are the fortress of our family. You are our loving God. You will go before us, our family and particular for the things that concern us today.

You are our rock, in whom we take refuge. You, our shield, and the horn of this family's salvation. For You are our stronghold, our refuge, and our SAVIOR. From the violent plans of the enemy shall YOU save us, for You are our strength. You show us unfailing kindness. To your anointed, You show unfailing kindness. We thank You for YOUR unfailing kindness to us and our family. For You are the Lord, our rock, our fortress and deliverer;

For you are our shield, our horn of our salvation, our stronghold present in times of trouble. For You alone have been and are our mighty refuge, a strong tower against the foe, and an ever present help in times of trouble. You are our loving God and our fortress, our stronghold, and our deliverer in whom we take refuge, YOU subdue people under us. For your NAME O Lord, is our strong tower and we as Your righteous we run to it, and are safe.

We declare that You alone are our God and You will never let the enemy pluck us or our families from Your hands.

- John 16:13-15- But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come. He will bring glory to me by taking from what is mine and making it known to you. All that belongs to the Father is mine. That is why I said the Spirit will take from what is mine and make it known to you.
- Psalm 33:20-We wait in hope for the LORD; He is our help and our shield.
- Psalm 59:9- My Strength, I watch for you; You, O God, are my fortress
- 2 Samuel 22:3- My God, my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield and horn of my salvation. He is my stronghold, my refuge and my SAVIOR from violent men you save me. (horn symbolizes strength)
- 2 Samuel 22:51- He gives his king great victories; he shows unfailing unkindness to his anointed, to David and his descendants forever.
- Psalm 18:2- The Lord is my rock, my fortress and my deliverer; my God is my rock, in whom I take refuge. He is my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold (horn symbolizes strength here)
- Psalm 61:3-For you have been my refuge, a strong tower against the foe
- Psalm 144:2-He is my loving God and my fortress, my stronghold and my deliverer, my shield, in whom I take Refuge, who subdues people under me.
- Proverbs 18:10-The name of the Lord is a strong tower; the righteous run to it and are safe.
