- 1. Roll Call: Selectman Dixon, Selectwoman Cyr. Absent Selectwoman Patterson.
- 2. Secretary's Report: None
- 3. Accessing and Abatements: None
- 4. Old Business: Correction about the Genetic Labs. Selectwoman Cyr wanted it to be known that the Genetics Lab did not come to Benton because there was no access to sewer lines and not because of Gary Dixon.

- 7. <u>Citizens' Concerns</u>: Kathe Bolster asked about the Transfer Station Contract. Selectwoman Cyr stated that the contract had been signed for a year.

- 9. <u>Bulger Property</u>: David Markowski spoke with the selectman about the Bulger Property and that it had not been cleaned up.
