## Ordinance No. 1005

An ordinance providing for the grading, paving curbing and otherwise improving of all that portion of the alley in block
No. fifty five (55) from the east line of Oak street to the west line of Main Street and the alley in block forty seven (47) from the east line of Walnut street to the west line of Oak street, all in the city of Garnett Kauses

WHEREAS; A resolution has been duly considered, passed and published declaring it necessary to grade, pave and otherwise improve the alley in block No. Bifty Five (55) from the east line of Oak street to the west line of Main Street and the alley in Block No. 25rty Seven (47) from the east line of Walnut Street to the west line of Oak street, and no remonstrance of sufficient strength as defined by the statutes, and within the time specified by the statutes has been filed, and,

WHEREAS; A resolution has been passed under the provisions of section 12-605 of the general statutes of Kansas for 1923 ordering the paving and otherwise improving of the alley in block No. Fifty Five from the east line of Oak street to the west line of Main street and the alley in block No. forty seven (47) from the east line of Walnut street to the west line of Oak street.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GARNETT, KANSAS:

Section 1. That it is deemed necessary, and it is hereby ordered and directed that the alley in Block No. Fifty Five (55) from the east line of Oak street to the west line of Main street and the alley in block No. forty seven (47) be graded, paved and otherwise improved with such materials as may be selected by the commission and built in accordance with plans and specificate tions prepared by Black and Veatch, engineers for the city of Garnett as approved, accepted and placed on file and are hereby ordered as the plans and specifications that shall govern the construction of the work.

That the cost and necessary expense incurred in such improvements anxanthorized xinxthis xordinancex shall be paid for by the owners of property liable therefor and by the city as a whole as it may be liable therefor.

That for the purpose of filling and completeing the improvements Section 3. as authorized by this ordinance, other necessary and legal steps will be taken as may be needed to comply with the provisions of the general statutes and bonds will be issued to pay for such improvements in accordance with the provisions of the statutes.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after tent days after its final passage and publication in the Garnett Review, the official city paper.
