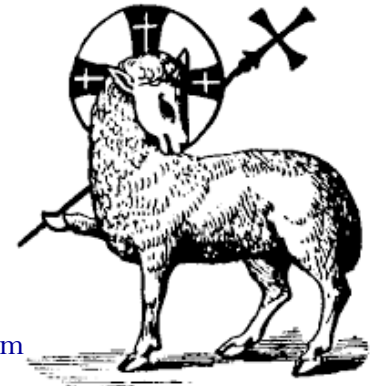

OUR PARISH STEWARDSHIP OF TREASURE CAMPAIGN CONTINUES

Our Parish Stewardship of Treasure Campaign continues. Its purpose is to provide for our parish's ordinary income used to address its financial needs supporting all of its work and ministries. Our goal this year is \$358,912. To date \$76,246.00 has

been received in stewardship pledges which represents 20% participation for our parish. This campaign is different from the Annual Catholic Appeal in the spring which supports the needs of the broader Archdiocese. All proceeds of this campaign remain in our Parish. These funds specifically support parish ministries, sacramental preparation, church and building maintenance and our staff and priest's needs. An introductory letter has already been sent along with a follow up letter including pledge cards. Please prayerfully consider how you might offer your support.



CONFIRMATION WILL BE CELEBRATED THIS SUNDAY

Eleven of our parish youth will be confirmed this Sunday. Bishop Eusebio Elizondo will be officiating. A potluck luncheon will follow in the Parish Hall. All are welcome.

The sacrament of confirmation completes the sacrament of baptism. If baptism is the sacrament of re-birth to a new and supernatural life, confirmation is the sacrament of maturity and coming of age confirmed by God's grace and complements and completes that of baptism. We ask that God may look kindly on our eleven candidates for Confirmation as they seek to hear His voice and to truly know the deep and abiding love that He has for each of them and to fill them with the joy of His presence.

Gracious Holy Spirit, strengthen our Confirmandi with your gifts of Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety, and Fear of the Lord, as a disciple of Christ. Increase in them the fruit of your Spirit. Help them to experience and trust your dwelling within, so that they may count on your guidance today and every day. Show us all the way to help one another become better disciples of Jesus Christ, sharing your love with our world and with each person we encounter.

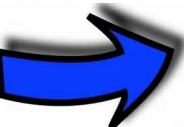


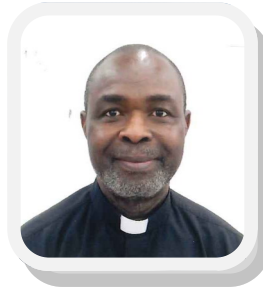

THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

The Fruits of Holy Communion

1397 *The Eucharist commits us to the poor. To receive in truth the Body and Blood of Christ given up for*

us, we must recognize Christ in the poorest, his brethren: You have tasted the Blood of the Lord, yet you do not recognize your brother, . . . You dishonor this table when you do not judge worthy of sharing your food someone judged worthy to take part in this meal. . . . God freed you from all your sins and invited you here, but you have not become more merciful.

1398 *The Eucharist and the unity of Christians.* Before the greatness of this mystery St. Augustine exclaims, "O sacrament of devotion! O sign of unity! O bond of charity!" The more painful the experience of the divisions in the Church which break the common participation in the table of the Lord, the more urgent are our prayers to the Lord that the time of complete unity among all who believe in him may return.

CATECISMO DE LA IGLESIA CATOLICA

Los frutos de la comunión

1397 *La Eucaristía entraña un compromiso en favor de los pobres: Para recibir en la verdad el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo entregados por nosotros debemos reconocer a Cristo en los más pobres, sus hermanos (cf Mt 25,40):*

«Has gustado la sangre del Señor y no reconoces a tu hermano. [...] Deshonras esta mesa, no juzgando digno de compartir tu alimento al que ha sido juzgado digno [...] de participar en esta mesa. Dios te ha liberado de todos los pecados y te ha invitado a ella. Y tú, aún así, no te has hecho más misericordioso (S. Juan Crisóstomo, hom. in 1 Co 27,4).

1398 *La Eucaristía y la unidad de los cristianos.* Ante la grandeza de este misterio, san Agustín exclama: *O sacramentum pietatis! O signum unitatis! O vinculum caritatis!* ("¡Oh sacramento de piedad, oh signo de unidad, oh vínculo de caridad!") (In Iohannis evangelium tractatus 26,13; cf SC 47). *Cuanto más dolorosamente se hacen sentir las divisiones de la Iglesia que rompen la participación común en la mesa del Señor, tanto más apremiantes son las oraciones al Señor para que lleguen los días de la unidad completa de todos los que creen en Él.*
