CCA Newsies Grabs Headlines and State Theatre Awards

The Iowa High School Musical Theatre Awards honored Clear Creek Amana High School's production of the musical "Newsies" with multiple awards. It was of the highest decorated shows in the state this spring.

The awards were made after judges attended a performance of the show at CCA when it was presented to the public in April. Judges attend all contender shows across lowa, score the performances based on many criteria, then awards are announced. This is the high school drama equivalent to winning a state tournament in a varsity sport.

The CCA ensemble cast has been invited to perform a portion of the show at the IHSMTA Awards Showcase on May 29 at 7 p.m. at the Des Moines Civic Center. In addition, production stars Carson Brandt, Mackenzie Burnett, James Cavanary and Sariah Sherman earned a spot at the Triple Threat Program for theatre loving high school students where they will compete for additional awards and scholarships.

Deb Kennedy and Tom Milligan who helped produce the show noted that CCA students led and complete all aspects of the production. These awards take in all of the work and special awards are given for behind the scenes efforts as well.

Winning Iowa High School "Outstanding Music Production," and "Outstanding Ensemble Production."

Outstanding performance awards were given to Carson Brandt, Mackenzie Burnett, James Cavanary, Sariah Sherman and Karley Griffen.

As "Newsies" tells the story of the real life 1899 newspaper boys strike that nearly took down newspapers in New York City. CCA students did a great deal of research on the actual historical events and incorporated what they learned into the show and into a special exhibit at the auditorium, Kennedy told us.
