About the Hand Me Up Program

The Hand Me Up program is a community based exchanged program that is designed to serve the residents of Anderson County who are pregnant or have children.

By participating in the program, eligible participants can earn "reward bucks" for keeping appointments (eye exams, prenatal appointments, immunizations, physicals, utilizing pharmacy services, and participating in educational classes).

In return, participants are able to redeem their "reward bucks" for infant and children's clothing, health and hygiene products, diapers, wipes, and toys.

The Hand Me Up program is organized by the Anderson County Interagency Council and is housed at the First United Methodist Church in Garnett.

- Complete a short application form, which can be done during the program's open hours at the First United Methodist Church in Garnett.
- 2. Start earning your reward bucks.
- When you are ready to use your reward bucks shop the community store during open hours at the First United Methodist Church in Garnett.
