Barry George Pawluk, 48, Caseville veterinarian, died Wednesday, Nov. 29, 2000, at his home. He was born March 7, 1952, in Detroit to Walter and Dorothy (Sharp) Pawluk. On Aug. 11, 1990, Barry was united in marriage to Karen Hayes at the Unity Church in Lansing. Barry graduated from Michigan State University School of Veterinary Medicine in 1976.
