STATE'S MOTION FOR DISCOVERY

The State of Arkansas moves the Court for Discovery:

I

The Prosecuting Attorney should be informed of and permitted to inspect and copy or photograph all reports or statements of experts made in connection with this case, including results of physical or mental examinations and of scientific tests, experiments or comparisons.

II

The Prosecuting Attorney should be informed as soon as practicable before the trial of the nature of any defense which defense counsel intends to use during the trial, (and) the names and addresses of all persons defense counsel intends to call as witnesses in this case, (and a short, plain statement of their expected testimony, which is reciprocal to Discovery granted the defendant).


