DESCRIPTION: This is a great looking and performing recurve. Bubinga riser. Comfortable grip. It was in excellent minty condition until the riser was cracked through as a result of a careless shipping handler. I used E40 bowyer's epoxy to inject epoxy into the crack in the riser to repair it. The repaired crack is still visible (see pics on last 3 pages) but the bow is solid and shoots great. Otherwise, the bow has no delamination; no other cracks; limbs are straight. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in great condition. There is a drilled hole where a bushing was inserted for a stabilizer (see pic on page 4). Two filled sight screw holes on the face (see left pic on p. 5); No chips or dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decals are in very good shape. After repairs, this bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the glues held and no stress cracks developed.) I then took it to the range to test shoot it. It shoots really well – smooth and accurate. Comes with a new rug rest and side plate, and a new string. Were it not for the repaired crack in the riser, this bow would be priced in the \$189 range. Priced accordingly because of the riser crack. I normally don't guarantee or warranty any vintage bow, but because of the repaired cracked riser, **I will warranty this bow for 2 years from date of purchase.** If the bow fails because of the cracked riser, I will refund your full purchase price, including shipping.
