

9.3	5.3	14.6	STRAIGHT onto Canal Road. (STRAIGHT @ traffic light, junction with Route 518). The Delaware & Raitian Canal is on your left along the entire stretch. You will pass Griggstown. Note: Sometime this becomes a single lane road, think be on the curves. On the weekends, cyclist #1 route.
14.6	3.2	17.8	Jog LEFT, then RIGHT at a Tand continue on Canal Road. Blackwells Mills. You'll come to the end of Canal Road in a tiny community of East Millstone where the road suddenly curves to the right, leaving you on Elm Street. (Note: on 603 and 632 I maybe off alittle, 2nd running I have 10.3, above is 11.0. It is a hell of a drive).
17.8	0.2	18.0	LEFT onto Market Street.
18.0	0.4	18.4	RIGHT at the T onto Amwell Road (Route 514).
18.4	0.5	18.9	LEFT onto Mettler's Road. LEFT at the entrance to the arboretum parking lot in Colonial Park (Rose Graden).
18.9	0.2	19.1	Rose Garden parking lot. RETURN to Mettler's Road.
19.1	0.6	19.7	LEFT onto Mettler's Road to Weston Road.
19.7	1.1	20.8	RIGHT on Weston Road to Elizabeth Avenue.
20.8	1.1	21.9	LEFT at the traffic light onto Elizabeth Avenue (Route 621).
21.9	2.1	24.0	LEFT onto School House Road. This narrow road is nearly traffic-free on weekends.
24.0	0.8	24.8	LEFT at the T onto Route 623 (Westin Canal Road).
24.8	10.0	34.8	LEFT onto Route 533 South (Millstone River Road). This pleasant country lane becomes very scenic after its junction with Route 514. The northerly flowing Millstone River almost touches the road.
34.8	0.2	35.0	LEFT at light onto Route 206 South, then an immediate LEFT on Montgomery Road.
35.0	1.4	36.4	LEFT at 'T' on Rt.206, almost an immediate LEFT on Montgomery Road. Stay on Montgomery Road as it swings into quite Rocky Hill, settled in 1701.
36.4	0.2	36.6	LEFT onto Washington Street. Town of Rocky Hill Here you'll pass the First Reformed Church, built in 1857.
36.6	1.2	37.8	RIGHT onto Princeton Ave at church, at 4-way Stop sign, go STRAIGHT When road forks, bear RIGHT, follow to intersection with Route 206. Fields and many large homes line this road.
37.8	3.7	41.5	STRAIGHT across intersection with Route 206, road changes to Cherry Valley Road.
41.5	1.7	43.2	RIGHT onto Province Line Road. This is equivalent to being on a newly paved roller coaster.
43.2	1.5	44.7	LEFT at stop sign onto Route 518. This road takes you into Town of Hopewell, which has stayed much the same as it was when founded in 1706. The gingerbread houses are an architecture delight.
44.7	4.4	49.1	LEFT onto Princeton Avenue, Route 569, Town of Hopewell. Farther down the road is the Educational Testing Service, creator of college entrance examinations.
49.1	2.4	51.5	LEFT onto Rosedale Road (Route 604) into Princeton. Settled by Quakers on the land William Penn purchased in 1693, Princeton's lush, tree-lined streets attached dozens of wealthy people, including Grover Cleveland.

51.5	0.4	51.9	RIGHT onto Elm Road, staying with Route 604.	
51.9	0.5	52.4	LEFT onto Route 206 (north) Stockton Street and STRAIGHT onto Nassau Street (Rt. 27).	
			As you get into the downtown area, look to your left for the Battle Monument, a local landmark. Nearby stand Morven, a circa-1750 Georgian-style mansion that serve for many years as the home of New Jersey governors.	
52.4	0.9	53.3	Straight onto what is now Nassau Street (Route 27).	
			The front of Princeton University is on your right.	
53.3	1.6	54.9	RIGHT onto Washington Road to Route 1 (traffic light).	
54.9	2.4	57.3	LEFT at light, ROUTE 1 North (divided highway).	
			RIGHT after passing under bridge, to College Road West, New Jersey jughandle (over Route 1 bridge).	
			Enter Forrestal Village, Westin Hotel.
