
Ice cream dessert 12" quilt block



Fabrics:

Foundation: Neutral color fabric

<u>Bowl</u> - 3 pieces/triangles of the same color fabric (teal on the picture) for each block <u>lce cream dessert</u> - 9 different colors of 2 ½" squares

For the foundation (neutral color):

A - Cut 4 7/8" square in half diagonally. You will need one triangle for this block.

B and E - Cut 2 strips 5" x 9 1/2"

C and D - Cut 2 strips 2 1/2" x 8 1/2"

For the bowl (teal color on the image):

A - Cut 4 7/8" square in half diagonally. You will need one triangle for this block B and E - Cut 2 strips 5" x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " diagonally: first strip from left to right, the second strip from right to left.

From this you will have two sets for 2 blocks.

Note: You can use batik, which has the same color on both sides, so when you cut triangle diagonally, you can simply flip it over to have two mirrored triangles.

For the ice cream:

Cut 9 pieces of 2 1/2" squares of different colors.
