

Susan Gene Fitch Thomas sent the following information about her Civil War ancestors.

Union-Paternal: Great Grandfather

Private Arthur Clark Fitch 72nd Ohio Infantry Regiment, Company B

He was mustered in at Camp Groghan near Fremont, OH, December 31, 1861, for a 3 year period. He was appointed Fife Major of the regiment in 1862.

He served in the battles of Shiloh, Jackson, & Vicksburg. He was detached for special service in Friedman's Camp in Memphis, TN, February, 1864. He was mustered out of service December 9, 1864, Columbus, OH.

Union-Maternal: Great-Great Grandfather

Private Jeremiah Fair 205th Pennsylvania Infantry Regiment, Company E

He was recruited from Burks Co., PA. The regiment was organized at Harrisburg, PA, September 2, 1864.

He served at the siege of Petersburg and Richmond, and the Appomattox Campaign. He returned to City Point and also participated in the Grand Review. He mustered out June 2, 1865.
