

MRS. WELLINGTON HORLACHER

Mrs. Wellington Horlacher died at her home in this city Monday, April 22nd. While she had been ailing for about a month her illness was not considered serious until a week before her death and the end came as a shock to the people of this vicinity.

Leah Martin was born in Waterloo county, Ont., April 30, 1863. At the age of six years she moved with her parents to Huron county, Ont., where she was united in marriage to Wellington Horlacher March 15, 1892. The same year they moved to Sebewaing and made that village their home until 1897 when they took up their residence in this village.

The deceased is survived by a husband and one daughter Daisy; father, Solomon Martin, of Hay township, Ont.; two brothers, Solomon, of Hay township, Ont., and Isaac, of this village; four sisters, Sarah, of London, Ont; Mrs. Henry Leibold, of South Cauga, Ont; Mrs. Elias Weidman, of McKinley township and Mrs. William Dietzel, of Oliver township.

The deceased was a member of the English M. E. church and always took an active part in church work. She was also a member of the Modern Brotherhood.
