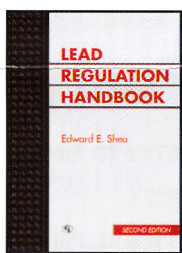


Transportation of Hazardous Materials Post-9/11

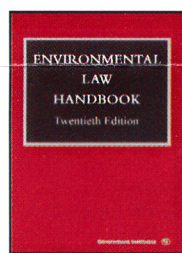
