Walter Robert Frank, age 93 of Caseville Township, passed away Friday, June 4, 2010 at Tendercare Nursing Center of Cass City.

He was born on April 5, 1917 in Caseville and was the son of the late Robert and Maida (Musselman) Frank. Walter is a Veteran of World War II, having served in the U.S. Navy.
