

COMMON ITALIAN WORDS

The official language of Italy is Italian. Here are a few simple Italian words/phrases.

Hi/ Hello/also Goodbye (informal) = ciao (chow)

Hello (any time of the day) = Salve! (sal-vay)

Good morning = Bouniorno (bwohn-johr-no) / Good evening = Bounasera (bwoh-nah-say-rah)

Goodbye = Arrivederci (ahr-ree-veh-dehr-chee)

Please = Per favore (pehr fah-voh-reh) / Thank you = Grazie (grah-tsee-eh)

You're welcome = prego (preh-goh)

Yes = Sì (see) / No = No

One = uno (oo – no)

Two = Due (doo – ay)

Three = Tre (tray)

Four = Quattro (Kwat-ro)

Five = Cinque (cheen-kway)

Six = Sei (say)

Seven = Sette (say-tay)

Eight = otto (ot-to)

Nine = Nove (no-vay)

Ten = Dieci (dee-ay-chee)
