

Clifford Township Parks and Recreation Board Meeting Minutes 1/22/20

October meeting minutes were approved.

A request was made to conduct pitching practice in the gym using hard balls. It was decided that only tennis balls can be used in the gym to minimize damage to walls and lights.

With the bridge construction expected to be completed this summer, a sign is needed for the Park/Community Center on 106, to replace the current signage.

The signs to complete the EMHR grant are in process and the township is in process of applying for a Land Acquisition grant.

Drainage and catch basins have been installed in the parking areas, the recycling area has been moved to the other side of the storage area, and widening the road on the left side of the building is being explored.

The bridge project across the creek continues to move forward.

Discussion took place about the knotweed problem along the creek and on park property.

The well casing was increased due to increased facility usage.

The gym has had new carpet installed on the walls, new pickleball lines painted and LED bulbs have been used to replace the current bulbs. A new air handler for heat is proposed and plans to add a furnace to the garage have been discussed.

The outdoor court is cracking and will be repaired in the spring.

Genevieve Larkin has not yet heard from her supervisors about whether or not her Gold Award Project has been approved to add amenities to the park.
