*'Becoming Living Spirit Word'*Bro. Lee Vayle - July 4, 1999

...sing this morning concerning You and Your Presence, realizing that this is a lot as it was in the days of Paul who said that if we say, "Jesus rose from the dead and he rose not then that is a lie." But indeed, he has risen and as we sing this morning concerning Your presence, we know we are not singing a lie but we are singing the truth because we have seen You visibly manifested here, not only in signs and wonders and great miracles, which only You can do, but, as the prophet said, "Even as it was in the days of Moses." When you sent him down to Egypt to deliver Israel, You not only appeared in signs and wonders, but You also appeared in the Pillar of Fire upon Mt. Sinai. And so today, and we have Your very picture; so we know you are here. We have passed from faith to knowledge, Lord, and when we come to knowledge we know there is no other place to go, because this is the ultimate, knowing that You are Your Own Word revealed today.

So we thank You for Your Presence, Your great revelation, knowing we have an ultimate and knowing that we are literally stranded, but that stranding is with You, O God, who created all things and maintain all things. And therefore, as the apple of Your eye today, this Bride, we know that we're in secure care and no matter what happens, we are with You and You will take us across and over, even as the prophet said, "Waters to carry us across."

So we appreciate that, Lord, and thank You that we are a part of it by predestination, not by our willful thinking, not by inviting ourselves, but realizing, "Blessed is the man whom thou choosest and causest to approach unto thy throne." [Ps 65:4] So we stay in that position this morning. May it be all through the service as the Word comes forth. In Jesus' Name we pray. Amen. You may be seated.

1. Now last night we got as far in this message of <u>Identification</u>, literally recapping and embellishing, that is trying to add more information. And, as we read and progress in what Bro. Branham was teaching, we find that in "Identification," he was identifying two seeds. And that is according to Scripture as we found in Matthew 13, the second mystery parable of the enemy that sowed the seed amongst the husbandman's true grain, or what we could call wheat and tares.

So, there are actually two people, then, they combined into one lump. At the time of the flood, there was only one person left, and that was Noah, who was a genetically pure human being or a true son of Adam through Eve, which would be a true child of Almighty God, genetically, biologically. All the

rest were already into that one lump of clay. And then you see Abraham being chosen by God after the flood and He said, "Now look," He said, "and in your seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed." [Gen 22:18] And so He takes one person, Abraham, and says; "Now you are going to be the father of all of my children that I'm bringing forth in the flesh."

And we find Paul speaking concerning Abraham, that he had one true wife, which was Sarah; and he had a concubine, which was Hagar. And Sarah got a little bit too excited and carried away and Abraham fell for it that he should have a child by Hagar. Well, you could be like one of Jacob's wives to have the women bare the child across your knees. It's still not your baby, period. So we see some real kooky fallacies here that are perpetrated by the women, which, not throwing off on women, but it's actually the fact of Scripture.

2. And so Paul has to say, "Yes, Abraham had two children, and one was by Sarah, which was the child of promise." And you'll notice the child of promise was literally a resurrection being, because Abraham and Sarah were a hundred years old and ninety years old, she was ninety, well past the age of bearing children. Now Abraham, at this time, was absolutely unable to be a father to a child and she was... and Sarah was unable to be a mother, as Bro. Brahham said, "A women that old, the milk veins would be entirely disappeared, there would be no way that... and so withered that she could ever have a child, she would die in childbirth."

So God took them back to where they were just a young couple, and that's a true picture of the resurrection. And at that time, just before the promised child in flesh appears, there's a Sodom and Gomorrah condition, terrible homosexuality, which must have led to great plagues and very tremendous acts that God hated.

- 3. But anyway, Paul dissertating upon this said, "Now you Galatians, I want you to know this one thing: you've forgotten that there are two seeds." Now one is the seed of God, and one is the seed of the devil. And of course, the devil cannot create, and the devil, of course, cannot procreate. There's no way that he can do it.
- 4. As much as you hear people trying the tell you the Nephalim or the giants were made by angels coming down from heaven and procreating with women, that's physical women here on earth, and bringing out these great big giants, that's the biggest bunch of hogwash you ever heard in your life. If that happened, why isn't it going on now? You can't do it. Angels are not able to procreate. Jesus himself said, "In the resurrection, you're like the angels in heaven. There's no marriage and giving in marriage." So how in the world did they come down and procreate? Hey, look! It's okay to be stupid and ignorant, but not before God. See? Not before God. If you want to be ignorant, that's fine. Paul

said, "He that's ignorant, let him be ignorant still," and he just washed them out of the book. [As long as they get] out of my way, because I will not tolerate ignorance. I will not tolerate stupidity.

And I'm saying this because you're in the view of a vindicated prophet. This is what that man said. And he—and confirms the Bible what Jesus said, angels don't procreate; they are sexless. Well, if they're sexless, my God, how can they procreate, because sex is for procreation? See? The whole thing is so utterly stupid.

Like I said last night, I got a little carried away. I wanted to vomit. It just nauseates me because, look: two and two are four. Teacher doesn't say to you and me, "Well," or our kids, "Well, what are two and two?" "Well, it's three." "Oh, very good, that's very good. You're close. Just off by one." Hey, one word off is death, period. And he that is guilty in one point of the law is guilty of all. So death entered by one word off.

- 5. So all right now, we find the human race one lump of clay and Abraham could only have a child of the flesh by his wife, Sarah, who was predestinated the same as Abraham was predestinated. Hagar was not predestinated. No way, shape, and form. And notice how today Ishmael is still trying to destroy the Isaac. And the Ishmaelites, that's your Muslims and the whole bunch of them, are out there as terrible thorns in the flesh of humanity, and they're causing all kinds of trouble and will do it. Israel owns that land, period! And I'm like Bro. Branham, I don't care if the Zionists got them there. God made the Zionists get them there. So that's what you're looking at one hundred percent.
- 6. Now okay, looking at the seed. There's two seed, and the Galatians could not accept that. Now you go back, you can read the whole book, and you'll come through various portions of Scripture that sway your mind this way and sway your mind that way. And that's fine, but what I want you to do as you read it, I want you to understand the Bible is not written to the sinner! The Bible is written to the seed of God. It is the Word of God.

In fact the Bible distinctly says God speaking, "How dare you as a sinner have My Word in your mouth?" You can't even have the Word of God in your mouth and not be condemned. The Word of God must be in the heart, in the soul, where it belongs, to feed the soul, as Bro. Branham said, "The Christ within you," because the Word of God, that vehicle, the... not the... well, you call the Rhema, the literal Word, mechanical Word, comes, it goes into the heart by the mind and the spirit and there it's translated into spiritual life. Now Bro. Branham categorically taught us that, we know that to be true, that's exactly why He defined us body, soul, and spirit. And he said it's no... "It is not body, soul, and spirit; it is body, spirit, and soul." And so he explained all that.

- 7. So Paul is explaining to the Gentiles and, notice, over here in the fourth chapter how the Word corrects the word. Paul is writing as a human body under the influence of the Holy Ghost, because he knows the Word. And as he tells us this Word. And remember, God uses the prophet and the wise men and the scribe. He sends all three. The prophet is the one who brings the Word of God direct. The wise man is the one who has the ability, like a five-fold ministry. And the scribe is one who simply writes it. So here, what you're looking at, you're looking at Paul who has the Word as the prophet, as a wise man, he is telling it. As scribe, he is putting it down. And watch, he corrects himself. In Gal 4:6,
 - (6) And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Sons into your heart, crying, (Father,) Father.
 - (7) Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

Well that's telling you right there, if you're truly born again, if you truly have the Spirit of God, this is one thing that you know: you always were a part of God. You will accept that. That is predestination. And the people cannot take it. They'll take predestination to the point where, "Oh yes, God knew, and He thought about it; and He knew, but He didn't do anything." Well, come on! How in the world can you do anything by just thinking when Jesus himself said, "How can you add a cubit to your stature by taking thought?" God doesn't just take thought, He takes action; because He's not only omniscient, He's omnipotent.

So, when you're looking at it, God does exactly what He wants in the arms of the earth, and nobody can say, "I'll not do Your will." These people here are being told. If you actually have received the Holy Spirit, if you are truly born again, you will recognize God as your Father. Not your earthly father and mother. What have they got to do with it? They said, "Well, you're mother ...?... who is my mother? Who's my father? Who's my brother?" The children of the kingdom. We are all accidents of birth in all... pretty well every single occasion in this church this morning. We do not belong to our mothers and fathers. They're the carriers, the incubators. We belong to God, the born ones of God, clothed in flesh to be tested. Now he's hitting these people right between the eyes with it.

8. Now he said, "Truly born again people will recognize sonship from God," birth from God and that means a part of God, because it's the life of God that you're looking at. Now he said, "Therefore you are no more servants; you're the free men of God." [Gal 4:7] And what is a free person? A free person is a person who does what he wants to do as though he can do anything he wants to do on the grounds it doesn't matter what anybody else does or wants; he'll do it anyway.

A real free person with real liberty is the man who is always right; and when he's right, he's right with God and his fellow human being. That's why the Scripture said, "How can you say you love God, [when] you don't even love your brethren or anybody else around you? You're so selfish and carnal." A real free man is always right. He knows what is right, and he does what is right. That's why

God is free. And He's free from everybody. And that's why Paul was free from the blood of all men. You follow his history, Acts 20; you'll hear it there.

- 9. So let's keep reading.
 - (8) Howbeit then, when ye knew not God, ye did service unto them which were by nature are no gods.
 - (9) But now, (Now watch, listen very carefully how the Word corrects the Word) after that ye have known God, or rather (I didn't mean that) are known of God,

Anybody can know that's God. "Oh, William Branham, a man sent from God." Even the devils believe in God and tremble. But who really believes that they're known of God, as in John, speaking of the shepherd, he said, "I know my sheep." But in Matthew 7, he said, "I don't know you." So the point is this morning how much you know God is infinitesimal and could be worth nothing to you but liability. The point is: does God know you?

10. As Bro. Branham brought out, the little girl out there, I think [she] was in Victoria or Vancouver, when the queen went by. And she began crying, and they said, "Well, didn't you see the queen?"

"Yes, but did she see me?"

Here, that's what he was talking about.

That's what... "Yeah, I saw, I know, those are works of God. Yeah, yeah, yeah. God does that..."

Oh, come on. You can go to hell for that. You can be put in the Lake of Fire. You could raise the dead. You can have miracles at your right hand and your left hand. You could speak in tongues. You can prophecy. That's why you see a preacher here this morning that's put everything to one side I've ever had in my life. Some of it I believe was from God. There [are] other things that I don't know. So I take nothing as from God except vindicated Word.

11. Now, if it's impressed in your heart that you're the true seed, you're on your way. But if you're baffled and wondering and looking around: there's something wrong somewhere, because this is the tie-post of the Gospel we're talking about. Bro. Branham, "Identification," have you identified yourself? Are you truly identified? Are you of God, or are you not of God?

12. Remember, the sheep hear the voice and the voice of God is always in the prophet. And remember, when Jesus comes down (that's Elohim-Jehovah comes down at the end time, in 1 Thessalonians), "The Lord descending with a shout," that is literally a message of subjection, putting the church in Divine Order, according to 1 Corinthians. And then there's a voice, and then there's a trumpet.

So you can see here, when it comes to the Rapture, there is going to be audibility and visibility, which nobody but the Bride will get. In other words what is audible will be taken only by the Bride. What is visible will be understood and put together only by the Bride. And only the Bride will be caught up in the Rapture. The rest will be looking around and wondering and wondering and say, "Well, wasn't this supposed to happen, wasn't that supposed to happen?"

As Bro. Branham said, "Always looking back, always looking ahead, never knowing what's going on at present."

I am a person who does not look back. I just talked to my sister this morning. She [wa]s going over her childhood. I said, "Myrt that's a sure sign you're old, when you begin talking about your childhood." I never talk about my childhood. How you going to talk about tomorrow? I'm waiting for a big surprise. I talk about today. And I'm not painting myself an example and my sister an example, a few people sitting here know me for all these years. You don't hear talk about Lee Vayle this, that, and the other thing. Forget it I'm not interested.

I'm interested in: has He got a hold of me? If He's got my hand I don't need to worry! But if I've simply got a hold of His hand I'd better have a worry, because I could slip loose. But I'll tell you, as Jesus Christ, who was pinned to that cross and could not get down until they took him down, so you and I are pinned to that same cross, crucified to the world but alive unto Almighty God, Who will take us absolutely and abundantly over to the other side.

13. Now Bro. Branham, in talking about this seed, you notice that he mentioned how that this seed positively went astray through Satan confusing Eve by the intelligent beast, and he so confused her that he got her completely seduced morally, mentally, and physically so that she became a pawn of him and by him introducing certain elements of explanation and what have you concerning sexology and reproduction, and perhaps even looking down the line, because the beast was very clever letting her know what could happen and what could be in the future, if she listened to him.

And that's how it always is, these strange angels, like the Mormons. Joe Smith had this stupid angel of some description come in and talk to him. Such assininity, my God have pity. And yet some of it is true; you've got to admit it, because there's no such thing as a solid lie, because there's no such thing as a lie anyway. The lie is nothing but the truth perverted. You know, let's face it, there's got to be original.

14. So anyway, [] many times you have these introductions of various types of things coming into the world, come and trying to assail us which assailed Eve, was leading us astray. In the New Testament it's called Gnosticism. It says this, as Paul said, "Look, this is the truth," and people came by and they said, "Now no, we've got a better idea. We'll tell you Paul just didn't give you the whole revelation."

And the devil came by and said to Eve, because you've got to go back to the beginning, if it happened at the time of Jesus and the Gospel of Paul, for the Gentiles had to start way back there with Adam and Eve. And then it had to go right into the Hebrews under false prophets and false religion.

She always comes in [and says], "I've got a better idea. I've got a better thing. Oh, I've heard from God. I'm superior. You listen to me and I'll give something more." So the devil, he said, "Now look here," he said, "You didn't get the full revelation." And it was the truth. It wasn't time for it.

Now you say, "Why God knows when you eat this your eyes are opened, and you'll know good and evil. You'll be as gods."

That was the truth. That was the truth; he knew it. It was still a lie, because he said, "You won't die."

He lied right there. But she looked at everything that would be a plus for her. And the plus turned into a negative, because the Word of God stood there.

[It said,] "Eve, I don't care what you know. I don't care how much you know. And I don't care how much is revealed to you. And I don't care how much I reveal to you down the road. And I don't care how many prophets come. I don't care anything. I'm telling you: you're dead; you're dead, because you dared to add one word. You dared to change this as though you know more than I."

Now there's a prophet right there. Who knows more than the Pillar of Fire above the prophet? When I said, "God eyeballed us, and we eyeballed God," the same in the day of Moses, I was telling you the truth. Yeah.

"Oh well, I don't approve of that."

Who told you whether you could approve of God or not.

"Well, I... I disapprove."

Who told you if you can disapprove God? Tell me. Do something, for God's sake do something this morning and show me. I'll tell you what I can do. I can read you this Word and show everyone fails and where everyone succeeds.

15. Now here's your guide. Now let's get this flat. The Bible was never written for the ungodly. It was only written for the seed and the godly. Paul himself said the Old Testament is for our example. We don't live by it. It's examples, and [It] shows you what went haywire while the right was there.

Now he said you can learn a lesson from all that. And Bro. Branham does the same thing. We'll see here he takes us to the Bible and shows you a vindicated prophet and the people who are seed who listen a vindicated prophet, because that's the gist of this whole message here. Identification: who are you this morning? Are you a child of God or aren't you? The very fact that you can recognize that William Branham's infallible, a prophet sent from God, that God spoke in and through him, that this is "THUS SAITH THE LORD," and you know that as your guide post, that is your step and you better hang on all of your life, tenaciously, and don't let anything come between you and that, because you've got to have it or you're going to go down the drain, because that's what happened to Eve. The minute she got from behind the Word, she was finished. See?

Now listen, God made her susceptible when He put her in flesh like Adam to fail or to win. She was a loser or a winner, and he was a loser or winner on the grounds of the flesh. Remember, every deed in the flesh must be tested by God and will be tried by fire and the person saved as by fire. So you better be careful what you sow.

Now you can be like the three little pigs, they were very, very stupid (at least two of them were), and one said, "Well," he said, "I can build my house of straw," and – poof, the wolf came by and the house was gone.

The second pig said, "I can build mine of wood," (it must have been a bunch of lath and a bunch of junk, got it from a junk guy). The wolf came by and blew; it was gone.

The third pig says, "Hey, I'm going to use bricks." That's a good little story about Christians, about people. If you want a brick house, you'd better take stone by stone the Word of God and build your house. Or, if you want wood, hay, and stubble, it will burn. But I'm going to tell you one thing: jewels and stones don't burn. So a man had better clothe himself with the Word of Almighty God.

- 16. So we're looking here, we're seeing "Identification" and in "Identification" the two seeds. We're going to go back here to the gospels, and then I'll start reading as quickly as I can. In Lk 12:27-32, if I have this right, and I hope I do.
 - (27) Consider the lilies how they grow: they toil not, they spin not; and yet I say unto you, Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.
 - (28) If then God so clothe the grass, which is to day in the field, and tomorrow is cast into the oven; how much more will he clothe you, O ye of little faith?

Now you notice that's what Peter is talking about over there, to be born again, when you should be born again.

- (29) And seek not ye what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink, neither be ye of doubtful mind.
- (30) For all these things do the nations of the world (or the Gentiles) seek after: and your Father knoweth that ye have need of these things.
- (31) But rather seek ye the kingdom of God; and all of these things shall be added unto you.
- (32) Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

He doesn't give it to anybody else but the born ones of God. When we pray, "Thy Kingdom come," we have an intensity in our prayer that the sinner cannot have, because it's going to be very

rough on him when the Kingdom does come, because he's cast out where there's weeping and gnashing of teeth while the others go into the Kingdom of Almighty God.

17. So you can see here the words of life are for the seed of God. They alone have a place to contain it. That's why the foolish virgin will never be Bride. They don't have the Word. They have the old word, like the bags that are worn out and the vessels that are creaky that won't hold the water any more. The true revelation has gone, and now God is ready with the new wine and the new revelation, and they don't have a place for it. See? They don't have it.

So that the Bride group always are the ones with the revelation that come in. The others are outside. They don't go to the Lake of Fire. As it tells you in Matthew, they go to the outside of the New Jerusalem, and they are those in the Kingdom beyond. But they are part of the Kingdom, because as in Adam, every single one died, so in Christ, every single one is made alive. That's exactly why little babies that die are fully predestinated by Almighty God, because they're under the Blood. It doesn't say they're going to be Bride, but they will be in the Kingdom. It says,

18. (32) Fear not, little flock; it's your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

Now listen, those words were back there in the Garden of Eden. [Do] you believe that? They had to be, because the Word was there. What happened to Eve that she got beguiled, that the devil could trick her out of the Garden of Eden? How foolish she was, and how foolish we can be, when we get off the gold standard. And remember, the streets of the city are paved with transparent gold. When we get off the gold standard of the Word of Almighty God, we end up in the slums. We lose everything but our souls, being a part of God.

That's why Bro. Branham said categorically, [as] I mentioned last night, "There will come a time when you'll find you always were saved," because you will wake up at one time in the face of false religion under a true prophet that tells you flat, "You were in God. You are a part of God." Then God put that into Adam and brought it down through the male, because he said, "You were in God," and in Christ. That is true, because it went right on down from the Father to the Son, the Only-begotten, and then on down to Adam and now to us. And he said; "Yet you were in your Father."

So in the male, in there, is that soul-life of God, or the true life of Almighty God. That's exactly why Bro. Branham said, "The woman is a righteous vessel, she's a sacred vessel put aside for child bearing." And that's why childbearing, taken in the Garden of Eden in a wrong context, so the children

are now born of sexual pleasure, brings it to the fact that every single one is born in sin and craven, c-raven, craven before Almighty God.

19. Listen, I am so thoroughly sold on Bro. Branham's commitment to the Word that he got from God that I couldn't be shaken no matter what happens, because this is "THUS SAITH THE LORD." And everywhere I turn, whether I turn to science, biology, no matter what I turn to, I find this Message is thoroughly vindicated and the world out there says, "Oh no, we can't believe that," certainly not, they weren't meant to believe, because only as many as were ordained will ever believe. And if you're not... Now not just predestination. There's ordination on top of your predestination. You weren't just foreknow. You weren't just elected. You weren't just predestinated. [You were] ordained.

In other words, as we showed you that sin is on an exponential curve, I have now shown you how the glory of God in us is in another exponential curve to where he finally says, "I'm at the door knocking, open the door. Let me come in. Let me advise you at this end time, and you'll sit with me in my throne as I sit on my Father's now." The exponential curve. And then the Bible said, "Eye hath not seen nor ear heard, neither entered into the heart of man the things that God hath prepared for them. But by the spirit we know them." [1 Cor 2:9-10] But Paul never delineated. The greatest delineation is on the New Jerusalem. And from then on, as far as the one thousand years (or better, whatever it is) in the Millennium, it is left almost hypothetical.

20. All right, let me just make your minds conjure up something at this point. How do you think Adam felt when he woke up, a man, to find himself in this fabulous garden? What do you think Eve felt like when she now had the senses and the physical ability, like Adam, to know that garden? Surprise, surprise, surprise! Now they knew something was there, but they'd never know reality until that was there. And as Bro. Branham said, "Before God ever made a fish with a fin to swim, He made waters to swim in." And let me tell you, before he ever, ever, ever had us ready for New Jerusalem, it was already there waiting for us. Surprise, surprise; because it says the glory has not been revealed but will be revealed.

And It gives us a little picture, and it says as the outer man is perishing, the inner man in being renewed day-by-day. How many really believe that? Do you believe you're really being renewed, or are you just sitting here perishing? It comes to the place where we must transcend everything through the Word of God and become transcended, not by some crazy meditation and some mantra, but by the full Word of the Living God wherein the Spirit dwells to take us there.

21. now, look over here in what we've read many times, and I know you're fully conversant with it in the book of Romans, the 8th chapter, and beginning at 28, "And we know that all things work together for good." How did Paul know them? And how did the people know them? Vindication!

Vindication--the a priori principle. H_2O : that's [] two of hydrogen, one of oxygen. Get the electric spark. Put them together, they're going to produce water, period. Everybody knows it. That's the a priori. It means every time it works. Put it here, it's there. Put it here together, it's there. Never changes.

You show me where any prophet ever changed the Word of God. Yet the people say this message is not scientific. Thousands and thousands and thousands and thousands of times Bro. Branham said, "THUS SAITH THE LORD," and not one failure. If that's not scientific, I'll eat it.

We've got some pretty sharp chemists in this building today, mainly, of course, Peter [Gatchell]. You know the law of chemistry, many times a man who thought he was smart failed, didn't he? It didn't combine the way they said. You know why? Because even though H₂O is water, and two of hydrogen, one of oxygen, if you don't combine them in just the right way, and under the right way, you're not going to get your water. And anybody knows that as a scientist and biochemist, you can take anything apart you want, and you can say, "Hah-hah, it's got this, this, this, this." "Well give me the same product this man has that made this, this, this, and this into this product." I can't guarantee it, because I don't know where he got his products, and I don't know how he put them together." Right? And the thing is-[Bro. Vayle makes sound of the experiment fizzling]--gone.

But a priori with God never fails! Now, you see, the Pentecostals get dumb. We get awe struck. Where's the balance between dumb and awe struck where the praises of God pour forth? Maybe they're just to be silent. Maybe voluble, but I look at it all, and I wonder.

- 22. Now let's keep going on. [Romans 8:]
 - (28) We know that all things work together for good that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

So the only ones who love God are those that are called according to his purpose. And what is His purpose? His purpose is over there in the Book of Ephesians: that we should be co-heirs with Jesus Christ through redemption of his Blood and placed as the sons, which we are, in that Kingdom where Jesus Christ now is fully manifest in a Bride. And now all of us are under the feet of God, because the Lamb is on the throne. God, Jehovah-Elohim is in a Pillar of Fire above the throne, and the Bride is around the throne with a hundred and 144,000 attendants, and all the rest are out there. And the holy archangels are there, and the cherubim are there, and everything is there that should be there.

But there is an intimate relationship, a complete love, intimate relationship, husband-bride, Father- Son, or children, and it all lies there in the great family of God, and God is in complete control.

- 23. Now that's His purpose. [Romans 8:]
 - (29) For whom he did foreknow, he did also predestinate to be conformed to the image of his son.

Now 'pre-destiny' means there's a destiny that you're going to get to. If I have a pre-destiny, I had better have the ability to get to that destiny or it is not a pre-destiny, it is presumptive. Show me where God is presumptive? Bro. Branham warned about presumption. Presumption is to go and tread where you have no authority. Show me where there's an authority outside of God, and I'll eat it.

"Well," you say, "The devil."

The devil does not have any authority of his own. He has been granted that, and it is temporary, because he and all else will be destroyed (of his ilk).

So let's get back to the truth. People don't want the truth. They don't want to isolate God. They want a hodge-podge God. God is not a hodge-podge God. He is not a God of vicissitudes. He does not change His mind. He is not frolicsome. He's not coercive either: the sheep hear the voice, and they follow. That's not coercive; that's family. That's family. Come on, that's genetics.

(29) ...That predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the first-born among many brethren.

Now if you're going to be conformed to the image, it means you're going to be one like him, and he's the image of God. So now we're a step down. And the step down is God, Christ, man, woman. And that, of course, is the figure of what? God and Jesus and the Bride. And then you've got the ones on the outside.

24. Now,

(30) Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called:

Certainly He had to. If you've got something, a niche, that you want filled, you'd better have something to fill it with.

So God says, "I've got to have..." (Let's just use the five-fold ministry, because that's easy.) God says, "Look, I've got to have a five-fold ministry for my children down there. Okay, I've got to have a prophet," there's a niche for a prophet.

"Oh man, oh man, there's a place for a prophet. How do I get a prophet? How do I get a prophet?"

Oh, come on. Before there was a need for a prophet there was already a prophet, before there was a prophet there was already a need for a prophet. You don't put God in segments and parts; this is one God doing the whole thing.

So all right,

(30) ...whom He did predestinate, he called.: (So you've got men with a calling.) and whom he called he justified. And whom he justified, them he also glorified.

Now the 'justified' means you didn't do it in the first place. Perfectly righteous and true. And if that's the case, God can do nothing but glorify you.

25. Now what does the Catholic do? "Oh, Mother Theresa..."

And I love the woman and everything she does. I've got nothing against her. I don't care if she's even a spiritist; she's a tremendous example. And you don't spit on anything that's a tremendous

example and faltering. She was wonderful and exactly for where she was and what she did. How many people have been like her?

"Well we're going to make Mother Theresa a saint."

Who said so? Who said so? Not that she's not a saint or couldn't be; I'm not against her being a saint.

Now they're going to elevate... No, what is it? John Paul I, is that what they called him now, the one that the people shepherd. Everybody loved him, the old boy? Now he's a great saint. Now Ignatius is a great saint. And this is a great saint. Who said so? What makes them think they can glorify? The Catholic Church went so strong under Pope Pius XII that he said, "Mary is ascended. Mary is ascended. Mary is ascended."

The theologians said, "Hogwash she's ascended!"

"Oh, but the Pope said so."

"Well then, Pope said so, that's it." My God have pity. That's where the Church has gone, not recognizing the sovereignty of Almighty God. Not understanding the truth of His Own children in one lump with the children of the brute, Satan vicariously had a son through the beast and the woman.

God did not have to do that. He had His sons, absolutely, because Abel was born one hundred percent positively a human—a true human being, a child of God, the same as Adam and Eve were. Seth was the same way and right on down the line to Enoch and to Noah, right down to David, right on down to Malachi, right on down to Jesus, right... and he was the fullness—right on down to Paul, right on down to William Branham. Right on down, all the time. Glorification.

26. (31) What shall we say then to these things?

What "these things?" The sovereign God doing what He wants, and what He wants is a family to express Himself, absolutely, under certain conditions which take a choice wherein they have the ability to do or not do according to the Word, because as a man soweth that shall he also reap. How can you sow the Word of God and not reap it? See?

That's where people get bumfoozled and crazy, but the Bible said, "You will reap if you faint not." [Gal 6:9] Stay with that Word. Stay with that Word. Stay with that Word. It'll get you there. And he said, "A man who takes his hand off the plough, my soul has no pleasure in him." So therefore, the soul of man must have pleasure in God by keeping his hand to the plough and staying with the Word. That's why you find the end time message, one word off, one word on; watch it. Then Bro. Branham finally made the definitive statement. I caught it, because I knew it had to be there, and he said, "It changes it." And one word added and one word off wouldn't mean one thing if it didn't change it, because I can take a double negative: it doesn't change anything. A double positive, verily, verily... Why do you need two verilys--truly, truly? Why do you say truly, truly? You don't have [to] if it's true in the first place; it's true in the second place, true in the third place. Then truly, truly, truly, truly, truly. No! Truth is truth; it's emphatic. See, that's all it was for. But you change it; you change the meaning. That's why he said, "I don't even dare use illustrations hardly anymore, it may change the meaning."

- 27. (31) What shall we say then to these things? If God be for us, (that takes care of it.) (That's what he said, absolutely, that takes care of it.)
 - (32) (For) He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?

Now he said here, this is the redemption that he spoke of in Ephesians predestination... Well, he... foreknowledge, election, predestination, which he didn't speak in Ephesians, but he brings it out here, this is that bird's eye view from eternity to eternity. Now:

- (33) Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth. (In other words who dares condemn me to death? God says, "I am righteous," that's a literal translation.)
- (34) Who is he that condemneth? (You can't, he said, "Christ died so therefore I cannot be condemned, because he took the brunt of the condemnation.")

And the brunt of the condemnation was not only that he bore our sins, but he erased them entirely, so how can you make a man a sinner and the Blood of Jesus Christ demolishes, erases, annihilates sin to the extent where there isn't any. You can't see it. And as Bro. Branham used the old illustration they used in Sunday School, when you see red through red, take a red glass and look at a red piece of cloth. It goes white. Looking at the red sin through the blood, though they're red like crimson, looking through the red glass, the light turns it into pure white.

In other words the Blood of Jesus Christ is the filter of Almighty God. Even as your filter and mine is the Word. God's filter is the Blood. Why? He's already got the Word. He knows that Word. He is the Word. Now you and I need the Word. The filter's there. [It] said you're righteous. Well how does a righteous man conduct himself? Here it tells you how to do it. Because you're still in the place of imperfection as long as you're in the flesh. Let me prove that to you, right over here in Romans 8, because so many people just don't get it.

- 28. Now It says here in Rom 8:6,
 - (6) To be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. (In other words, to be minded of the Word, go by the Word instead of natural instincts, you're going to have life and peace.)
 - (7) Because this carnal mind is the enemy of God: and is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.
 - (8) So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.
 - (9) But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.

There's your seed again. If you don't have that part of God, the life of God, in you, that started your body, giving God's life a temple, (because your body is the temple, giving God that place), you're not one of His. You're out of it. Now watch:

(10) And if Christ be in you, (even if Christ is in you) the body is dead because of sin; (You're going to die anyway, I don't care how many times you're baptized with the Holy Ghost, how many times you're healed. Everybody dies; every Christian dies. What does it say?) but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.

So you go on, and you get a new body.

29. Now he tells you all about it over here, and there's no condemnation. He said, "How dare any man condemn me to death. Can't do it." Why? Because Christ is risen, the Blood took care of my sins. The Spirit came back upon me granting me immortality after the Resurrection. Now then what happened? Jesus is standing there for me, and he is there with his own covenant with God. Now I want to express this. I've stood with it many, many years and taught it: Jesus, the Son, has his own covenant with God concerning us. And Jesus respects that covenant and God respects that covenant that has concerning us, and he said, "I'm going to get every one of them back, as in Adam all die, even so in me I'm going to raise them all up." That hasn't got one thing to do with you or me, except we will be there.

Now the thing is in what condition are you going to get there? What are you sowing this morning, the Word or... If you're not sowing the Word, you're going to reap what you sow. Teach your kids that; show them that; let them know that. Now they're trying to put the Ten Commandments in the schools. What about that one: "Thou shalt not commit adultery."

Then say, "Here boy, take a handful of condoms."

Blasphemy! Don't try to mix the Word of God and politics, and don't try to mix the Word of God with a bunch of vile sinners. God condemns them for even using the Word. Because you know why they'll use it? They'll try to use it as a stepladder for their own righteousness or condemn somebody.

"Well you can't have prayer in the school..."

Personally I don't care two bits about prayer in the school.

We had prayer in the school, what good did it do me? I'd go to church and pull the wings off of flies when I could catch them. Take a tooth pick or a little pen and a little bit of cork on each end and put the fly on another pin, and he had little barbells going back and forth, because the preacher annoyed me. Well I'll tell you. One day I met him face-to-face. Yeah. Yeah, yeah; the Arabs, the Muslims, they all have they're prayers for each several times a day, and they've got the Ten Commandments. What good has it done them? Huh? What good? Oh I could start really reeling off right now, but I'm going to let it go, because it's not... I'm not in the mood anyway.

- 30. All right. Let's keep reading. [Romans 8:]
 - (35) Who shall separate us... (Now notice it says... it doesn't say 'what,' it says 'who') shall separate us from the love of Christ? (Who separated God and His favorite children in the garden? Satan did. Now then, now he says what? And... but you can tell who sends it.) tribulation, distress, persecution, famine, nakedness, peril, or sword. (Devil sends it all.)
 - (36) As it is written, For thy sake we're killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.

(37) Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.

In other words God being a Savior, God being a healer, God being a provider, God being a protector, God being peace, by being this and that. All these things have to come to give Him glory.

- (38) For I am persuaded, (I have been persuaded, absolutely, this is a thing of the past) neither death, life, angels, principalities, power, things present, things to come,
- (39) (Height, depth, nothing, nothing, no creation is) able to separate (me) from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus the Lord.

He said, "I've got there, I've arrived. I'm a child of God; try to do something about it. I'm one of His, I'm born of Him, try to do something about it." In other words, drop dead. "I'm ready to die no matter what it costs me," said Paul. "You can't change me." And the thing is this: he's telling you that nothing will ever change the fact that you are seed of God, or you're not seed of God, period. You can't add a cubit to your stature by taking thought. Neither can you ramble through the Scripture by just thinking about it. It has to be a revelation. The food lies in there.

31. Okay, do you want to see the truth of this whole thing? It's over here in Romans 5. Now the reason I'm doing this is because--Bro. Branham talked about the redemption--the seed of God that went astray, had to have a redeemer of their own but superior to. And redemption is to buy back. Redemption has nothing to do with the reprobate. The reprobate means rejection. Rejection is at the White Throne: "Depart from me I never knew you." It's in Matthew 7, "Depart from me I never knew you, get out of here." It's in Matthew 24; right down the line you can see it. Revelation 20, and you see the pure picture of Revelation 21 and 22, the New Jerusalem, coming down of God, nothing in there to defile, every plant the Father hath not planted is gone.

So redemption is solely, one hundred percent, for those who left Christ, were severed from him where the Holy Ghost binds you back, every single one; not one shall be lost. As in Adam, not Eve, as in Adam all died. Even so in Christ, in identical manner--in identical manner--made alive in Jesus. In other words I was a pawn in Adam; I'm a pawn in Jesus. That's hard preaching, because the words are not nice, but it's the best words I can use. In other words I am completely manipulated by Almighty God, even though it doesn't look like it, even though men will say, "No." But you will find this: it will come to pass one hundred percent. In the mean time the warning: be careful how you live because everything you do will meet you and you will be tried as by fire.

How would you like the clothes all burnt off you, and yet you didn't get a third degree burn or any burn standing there naked, and you'd say, "Oh, boy, O God, what a terrible thing, what a—what a

terrible thing, what a terrible thing, I could've burned to death. I walked out, but I could've burned to death. Now I haven't got a thing. I stand naked"

Judgment. Judgment. That goes for you; goes for me. Don't just talk about it. Don't just talk about it. Believe it, and act on it. Start sowing to reap. Start sowing to reap. And if you faint not, you will.

Mr. Clinton said that on his inaugural address in 1992. What happened? He got right into his sexual sins, and he's reaping it, and he will go down in history as a sexual deviant. And no matter what they say about winning the war... Winning what war? Just try to keep the peace. Yeah. Okay, let's forget about him.

32. Over here in Romans 5, It says,

(1) Therefore having been justified by faith (not being justified, you're not 'being' justified, you have been or you ain't, the Greek says have been justified), we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: (And that means God is at peace toward you and me.)

"Oh," you say, "I... 'being justified, we have peace,' O Lord, O Lord, my heart, my heart, my heart, my soul, my peace."

Shut up! You were taught wrong. That has nothing to do with you. It has to do with God. God's not mad anymore. God's not angry. He's angry with the sinner all the day long, but He's not angry with us. He's the Father watching us and correcting us and helping us. As the Psalmist said, "Lord correct me but not in hot rebuke and in anger." No. Correct me by Your Word, O God. Show me Your way, and I'll walk in righteousness. Thy Word have I hid in my heart that I might not sin against thee. Read Psalms 119. Read it carefully. See? Have we had peace with God?

33. Now watch:

(2) By whom we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand (why that's your mediator and intercessor), and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God. (That means a sure expectation of what God said is for us. That's why he goes to the 8th chapter and explains this thoroughly.)

- (3) And not only so, but we glory in tribulation: knowing (knowing, knowing, knowing, we've been taught, we understand, we inculcate in our lives, we produce it, we know something about tribulation, testing and trial, it's good for us) it works patience;
- (4) And patience, experience (patience, experience? No, knowledge, a true understanding of what is going on. God is dealing with us. God is helping us.)

That's what Romans 8 says. Tribulation, peril, nakedness, sword, doesn't matter. God dealing with us, bringing us to... Then what does It say here? And that's going to bring us to hope, which is earnest expectation. Why? Because now we can expect it.

- (5) And (earnest expectation) makes us not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given to us. (In other words, you come forth triumphant. You're going to. It says,)
- (6) For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.
- (7) (Now) for scarcely for a righteous man will one die; but peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die.

But watch... Now this is that redeemer that Bro. Branham talked about that was a superior quality, although a Son, the only begotten Son, reflected the true character of Almighty God, was the image of God, God was in him as in no one else, he was the full Word revealed.

- (8) ...while we were yet sinners, (this one,) Christ, died for us.
- (9) Much more then, being now justified by his blood, (not bull and goats) we shall be saved from the wrath through him.
- 34. In other words, declared righteous and Jesus standing there as, not only the one who gave the will or the testament, but who died and rose again in order not to be the testator or the writer of it, but to be the executor of his own will. In other words this whole book is fulfilled to you and me right now for the hope and glory of God. It is ours, and Jesus is seeing to it. That's his covenant with the Father. He's got to see us through. So shut up and sit down and rid your heart of every evil thought, because every thought contrary to this Word is evil.

And every perversion... look at what It says: "As in Adam [all] died; in identical manner..." As in Adam, even so, doesn't matter; all are made alive in Christ. Identical manner. What did you have about your death in Adam? Nothing. What did you have about your death in Christ? Nothing. What do you have about your resurrection? Nothing. But you were there all the way through, because you're a part of that history, and you're a part of God and came on right on down through.

- 35. Now It says here, [Romans 5:]
 - (9) Much more being justified, we have saved from the wrath,
 - (10) For when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of His Son, much more, being reconciled, we should be saved by his life.

Now, in other words, It tells you right there, if Jesus' death took all the wrath of God from you, but if that's all it did, that's pretty punk. That's not good enough. Now his life comes into play, the very life that he loosed when his Blood was shed cleansing the heavenlies, yet the blood falling upon the ground, going back to the elements, signifies Bro. Branham's perfect truth, the life came back upon the believer, which the animal life could not do. So therefore, true salvation is the baptism with the Holy Ghost.

(11) And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement.

So what is he saying about it? He's bringing out the same thing again: one is intercessor, now it's the mediator. And he talks about the mediator second to the intercessor, although the truth of the matter is you have to have the mediator to get you in and the intercessor to keep you in. The intercessor's the high priest. That's his life. He's the high priest.

- (12) Wherefore, as by one man sin entered the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for all have sinned:
- (13) For until the law sin was in the world: but sin is not imputed where there is no law.

That's true. If there's no 25 mile [per hour] zone that you can't exceed, then you can do 55 or 100 or whatever it is. And, when there's no law, there's no sin. Nothing's spoken against it.

Like Paul said, "All things are lawful, but all things are not expedient." [1 Cor 6:12] In other words, watch what you're doing. You're free but watch how you sow. Watch how you sow. Watch how you... See, here's eternal security. God has said, "I'm going to get my sheep back. They're going to get there." Are you going to get there tried by fire naked? Are you going to get there well-clothed with your crowns that no man take thy crown. Let no man take your position. Let nobody take your place. Are you going to die ahead of time because you willfully sin, and God could've used you, wanted to use you? In other words, don't fool with God, because you're the billion, trillionaire's son whose limited resources to take you from here to there, even get you out of the chicken coup and hell-hole of death, lift your body up glorify you. What condition you going to be in? It's all written out here for you.

36. Now:

- (14) Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over them that had not sinned after the similitude of Adam's transgression, who is the figure of him which was to come. (That's a negative type.)
- (15) But not as the offence, so also is the free gift...

Now look at... You're looking at something here; he's saying, "There is no comparison between the two."

37. Now I want you to know something. When was this world more evil than just before the flood as it is now? [End of side one of tape] The answer is this: at no time. When was it more perilous? At no time. When was it more filthy? Never, except before the flood when men's bodies were dying and oozing puss, infection, dirt, and filth upon the ground which couldn't even cleanse itself, because all the good bacteria was gone. Think a moment. Filthy homosexuality.

Senator Feinstein, the mayor of San Francisco, where she so ignobly portrayed what she was, even letting the newsmen know about a serial killer. He had certain kinds of shoes. And so the guy dumped his shoes in San Francisco Bay and went on killing people. Wonderful woman we got, yeah. Bro. Branham said the most horrible thing America did was give women the vote. I couldn't believe that till just about a month ago when I saw women making decisions, and I said, "My God, the man's right."

Look at the decisions the women are making. Now we got Mrs. Dole going to be President, El Presidente. She might be Vice President, 'vice' meaning sin. Oh I can put a play upon words. Don't worry. And it'll be like a vice on the nation too if she begins tightening up. A little different spelling, but it's all right. Same pronunciation.

38. All right listen. The condition is so filthy and so rotten today that you want to vomit. Let me tell you something. The filthy condition is here but the righteousness of Christ and his glory is trillions and trillions times greater than the awfulness of sin.

So when you're looking at this Scripture, you're making comparisons all the way through. It says: [Romans 5:]

(15) Not as the offence, so also is the free gift. (No comparison.) For if through the offence of one many be dead, (Now notic, It didn't say every man. It says many. What are the many? The children of God.

They're the many.) much more the grace of God, the gift by grace, by one man... hath abounded unto many.

In other words, if we have something that's pulling us down to death and destruction, we've got something trillions of times greater pulling us up to eternal life and glory in Almighty God.

(16) And as it was that one man sinned, so is the gift: (In other words, no comparison) for the judgment was one by condemnation, but the free gift is... unto justification (even though you have many offences.)

And that says, "I didn't do what Adam did. In fact, I might have done many many times worse than Adam. And I'm such an imperfect creature even now..." But just a minute. You have a mediator getting you in; you have the intercessor holding you in. And let me ask you one question: can there be a comparison between him and us what we did and what he did? No way. The answer is: infinite. In other words, incalculable. It cannot even be told.

- (17) For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one Christ Jesus.
- 39. I want to ask you a question: how bad does sin rule in your life? You say, "I've had a terrible time; got a terrible time now."

That's minimal compared to what Christ can do in a man's life, especially if he learns to get out of the way. Then what lies for him in the future? Bro. Branham told that, and Paul told us the same thing.

- (19) For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, by the obedience of one many made righteous. (Notice the word many again, not everybody.)
- (20) Moreover the law entered, the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound:
- (21) That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through righteousness... (Notice grace can only come through righteousness.)

In other words the covenant of the Son with the Father is the big thing. So let us glorify that and not look upon ourselves and our word in relationship and say, "Well, my, I'm a miserable failure; man I just don't know this, and man I don't know that. I don't know if I can receive this. I don't think I can receive that."

Bumble, bumble; grumble, grumble, grumble. Oh shut up for God's sake. Sit down and shut up and never get up again. Never get up again. Just grovel in the dust until you learn, "Let every man's word be a lie, but God's Word is true," even what he said about me. And I am a liar, so I'm lying to myself, and I'm lying in the face of God. For God's sake shut up and sit down and never get up again. That's what you're looking at brother/sister. That's what you're looking at. And I'm going to tell you one thing: I've got it hard the same as you do. You're not looking at any vice less, virtuous person here; see?

40. So okay. Thus we see [that] in Jesus both God and man were reflected, because it could never be anything else. How could any man of himself ever have this righteousness spoken of, when sin is so desperate, so virulent, so vicious, so vital living within us, so intolerable, so pervasive, so powerful, so conquering?

I can't do. I'm bound. It would take more than a man. It would take a man amongst us, the Only-begotten Son, one uniquely born, from his Father's loins and from his mother's womb, one-of-a-kind, never, ever to be again, one that was the complete tabernacle of Almighty God. One that would ascend after his death and resurrection and be lord and God hath made him Lord. So there's two Lords, one is the Father, one is the Son.

The people that say they believe this Message don't even know that much. They're only Jesus-Only, a bunch of Jesus-Only. Say there's two Lords. Tell them you can worship Jesus, he's worthy of worship, the Bible says so. Your [Bro. Vayle makes sound of a person in distress] nutty as a fruitcake. Minds completely gone. They need their brains baptized with the Holy Ghost. Let me tell you something brother/sister: don't forget what the prophet said, "This Word's got to go to your brain, down by your spirit and your soul, and there becomes life."

If your brain's not baptized with the Holy Ghost, you can't read, and I can prove it. I proved it up in Saskatchewan years and years ago. A bunch of Mennonites there were running down Bro. Branham, and I said, "They can't even read. My Bible says, 'The one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,' why do you read it 'the God Christ Jesus?'" It shut them up for about three years; then they got back on the trail again. Can't read. Pentecostals can't read. Mennonites can't read.

Jim went down to Jeffersonville one time; there was a picture of a bunch of Mennonites on Bro. Branham's desk. Bro. Branham having deceased, they brought the question up about Amish people rather, and Billy said, "My dad said, 'They're every one dead.'" How could Bro. Branham say otherwise? Why... Otherwise he could not have said, "Baptist, Methodist, witchcraft." And people running around a little scared.

Oh. they're worshipping... They've got (you know) places where they worship and God, the devil, and they have witches and everybody's getting scared these bunch of nice Trinitarian people out here, Pentecostals, not just them mostly (they don't care too much), but the Methodists, all the rest of them, they're talking, "Oh my, Satan worship, Satan worship." That's the biggest laugh in all the world. "Baptists, Methodists; witchcraft."

Not a little covetousness stupid idiots getting together with a little séance, and pretend to worship spirits and devils. And everybody's running scared. That doesn't scare me one bit. The percentage of those people in America, they're not even one third of one percent. Maybe one hundredth of one hundred percent. Or maybe one thousandth of one percent. The devil takes it and blows it up, and the religious people all run, and they don't have a clue about the covenant of the Son with the Father and what the Son did for us, and we walk in.

What shape are you walking in? That's the whole thing: what shape are you walking...? Then the leaders come along, and they say, "See now, if you do this you're lost. You do this you're lost." Oh no you're not. You don't get lost. All of your deeds are lost, and you are saved as by fire. Maybe a few little blisters on your skin to let you... No, not really, not really. God doesn't do that. It's enough to know what you missed. It's enough to know what you missed. I hope we're not living with that, because that would be bad. That would be terribly bad.

- 41. Jesus, born of Mary, became the perfect mirror of God, God could reflect through him. He was the Only-begotten Son, revealing not himself but the Father, and in so doing, he revealed himself. Let's go to 1 John 1: and It says,
 - (1) That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled of the Word of life.

Now they did that. That's not God. They looked upon the flesh and through the flesh and what was done. You saw God, but no man can see God and live. So God was in the Son, veiled in the Son. And they handled this one, and he was the Word of Life, because he's part of his Father. That's why God can be Logos, and the Son can be Logos, and that's why you and I are Logos too. Logos is just a simple strange word that simply means 'the expression of what lies there', and it has to contain what lies there.

In other words, if a man had a vision of a fork, he said, "I've got an idea." That fork has got to come into reality. And so it turns out a spoon. No, a fork is a spear. So if the fork is not a fork unless it's

a spear. A spoon is not a spoon, unless it's concave. Logos! Don't get all messed up with Logos. Make it some obscure thing. Listen to what the prophet said. Time after time you'll see him swing back and forth, and as he swings back and forth you can understand Logos. And when you come to Jesus as Logos, that's perfect, absolutely the manifested one in flesh who was previously invisible, only a light; nobody could see it unless God ordained it.

- A2. Now he comes down here. And his essentiality is in what you see. So we handled the legitimate, Only-begotten Son through flesh. The same as you and I were in God and are flesh. And when you're looking at us, strange to say, you're looking at a part of God. And when you handle the flesh, you're handling a part of God, on the fact that God is in here. And I can read you out of 2 Corinthians and show you where Paul said, "Except you have the Spirit of Christ, if you don't have it, you're a reprobate." And that means rejected. And that means, "I never knew you." So therefore, if [you] don't have a part of God, you're not seed of God. You're not a part of His life, and He's not a part of you. You're not a part of Him. You're out. This is what we're talking about. This is for you and me I'm reading about here.
 - (2) For the life was manifested, and we have seen it.

Now life was manifested. It tells you the life was manifested. The life was there, but what if it wasn't manifested? You wouldn't have held it; you wouldn't have seen it, you... So Logos is manifestation. Come on. Reality! Get with it. Put it in the open. Let's work with it. Work on us. Come on. Get with it. Experience, reality. Come on. That's what he's talking about. Or is he wrong? Maybe I'm wrong, maybe I'm just a little bit upset up here.

- (2) ...and show unto you that eternal life, which was with the Father, and was manifest unto us; (Or was he with the Father was he not?)
- (3) That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have fellowship with us: and truly our fellowship is with the Father, and his Son Jesus Christ. (There's two of them.)

"Oh, I believe Jesus is the Father."

How could he be the Father? He's the Son. Now every man here that's a father, you had a father. Are you your father? No. You're part of the life of your father as he was a part of the life of his father, back, back, back, back, back, back, all the way. And then you get back to where your father was either a serpent or Adam. No problem. Oh man, you know this is so simple. You know the only way you can go haywire is to want to go haywire.

- (4) Now these things we write that you may be full of joy.
- 43. Okay, let's go to John 1, the Gospel now, and we're going to see something in verse 14.

(14) And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we beheld his glory, the glory of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

So therefore, when Jesus shone forth the glory of God, he also was glorified and shone in his own glory. Oh, what a character this one was. Here's where the Father indwelt the Son. "This is my beloved Son in whom I'm pleased." And Bro. Branham used the words 'dwell in'. It's not in the Scripture, but they are to me, because Bro. Branham said so. In other words it becomes super to us.

- 44. Now here is a picture of sorts. Of sorts I said, I'm not talking of perfection, of sorts in the days to come, in Col 1:12.
 - (12) Giving thanks unto God the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light:
 - (13) Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: (and we have been.)
 - (14) In whom we have redemption through his blood, and the forgiveness of sins: (Now you see, if we got verse 14, we certainly got the rest. Now watch about this one,)
 - (15) Who is the image of the invisible God, (tells you that,) the firstborn of every creature:

In other words he was the first one here after God. Now I ask you a question: Did he become a creature? Well how could he become a creature? Didn't God create the sperm and egg?

45. All right. The Book of Revelation says that he is the beginning of the creation of God; God forming Himself in the form of human flesh. In other words, way back there when the light came forth, that was the beginning of you and me. God, moving through His children, all started with Jesus. That's why he's elder brother. He's not ashamed to call us His brethren, and that's what we are. See?

Okay, let's keep a little. [Colossians 1:]

- (16) For by him were all things... For by him all things created, that are in heaven, and are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, dominions, principalities, powers: all things created by him, and for him:
- (17) And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.

That tells you right there: Bro. Branham gave a perfect picture of the Genesis, the light coming forth, the Son, like a child playing around the father's doorstep creating all these things. It's there. Bro. Branham gave us the reality.

- 46. You know, this man William Branham was certainly a character, and I'm using the word 'character' in the utmost sense of the purity of the Word. Absolutely tremendous individual; standing right there with Moses and Paul. Oh, the Pentecostals love that one, don't they? Ho ho. []
 - (17) He is before all things, and by him all things consist (or maintain.)

In other words he's the starter of it, he's the holder of it, he's the finisher of it, and the new beginner of it or whatever it's going to be, he's going to be right there, the Father working in and through him. Now watch,

- (18) And he is the head of the body, (which) is the church, (the true Bride: and he) is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things he might have the preeminence.
- (19) For it pleased the Father that in him should all fulness dwell;

Now what you're looking at here is where the finality comes where the body, not one more member, can be added to it. Not one member taken away. And it goes right to the Eternal City, as far as I am concerned. And there you'll see the full picture of God wanted and did through that one, that fullness of the body. And when I use the term 'body,' to me, it's whatever God is doing in bodies--whatever. But whatever he does outside is His Own sovereign grace and ability and no man, not even the Son, has any part in it, because the Son is not part of Godhead. He is a part of the Father, Who is God. Oh man, there's a difference in those things.

- 47. The same thing we find in Eph 1:22–23. And it says,
 - (22) Who put all things under his feet, and gave him to be head over all things to the church,
 - (23) Which is his body, the fullness of him that filleth all and in all.

In other words it tells you right there that every single thing that God poured into Jesus, He wanted it poured in for the church. We do not believe, as some people teach... I don't know about here.

Well, I'll use this up here. These are supposed to be three tumblers. All right, this tumbler represents God. So God pours it all into Jesus. So throw the tumbler away. All right, this is Jesus; now he pours in the church. Throw this one away. Hogwash. Hogwash; corruption; stupidity. It says 'bodily'. And whatever God wanted bodily, He poured into Jesus, poured into the church so we come forth just

like him in the Resurrection, and there you see it. That's my understanding. You take yours and do what you want with it.

But I will never concede for one minute that Jesus is God. And I'll never concede for one minute that the church is Jesus. I will only concede what the Scripture says, and Bro. Branham in finality, that the Holy City, 1500 miles wide, 1500 miles high, it's four-square at the base, 1500 miles high... It's a pyramid, and at the top is the Elohim, the Pillar of Fire. Under him is the Lamb on the throne. And under that is the Bride and a few attendants. That's bodily, because God is not in a body.

God is headship, the great Fountain of Life. And that life coming through the Son to all of us, stand there. And I say that is what means the Scripture God and body, and God poured into Christ bodily. He was the fullness bodily. And I put this to you; show me one place where anybody is in there outside of being in Jesus, who did it all through the body. As in Adam, body, all die; even so in Jesus, body, all made alive. I could be wrong. Do what you want.

48. Bro. Branham describes a New Jerusalem, which is now in view according to 1 Corinthians 15, and this is the ultimate and the very final, what he's talking about in "Identification." Now we're identified with this on the grounds that we are it. That's why years ago we started to sing, "we're not marching to Zion," "we are marching Zion," because our mother is New Jerusalem from above. So we're a part of her. So we're marching. The Holy City has come into view. Read what Bro. Branham said under the Seventh Seal. You'll get a picture.

People forget that. They forget that dynamism of the Seven Seals where they keep on saying, "Well the Seventh Seal wasn't opened."

Bro. Branham said, "The seventh seal is open, but it's silence. There is nothing there that I can tell you about."

It's open. He says so. Now they say it's not open, but he said it was.

Then he said, "It's not revealed to the public." And one day he said, and nobody caught it, evidently, until after he died, "The seventh seal is Rev 10:1-7," revealed to the public.

"Oh, it's not revealed. Oh, it's not revealed. Oh, it's not revealed."

Like one guy quoted Bro. Branham not long ago and caused great confusion. He said, "Well Bro. Branham said the elder was next to the Holy Ghost."

Ho, I said, "Come on, stop it." There's two kinds of elders Bro. Branham was talking about: the elder John and those elders. He wasn't talking about a man that a congregation can ordain as an elder in the church. They're the ones that lead the church astray. Read the Bible, Acts 20, and read what Bro. Branham said; "The pastor is the supreme authority in the church," that's next to the Holy Ghost.

49. Now listen. I've got one word for trouble makers who hear these tapes: shut up and sit down, because you'll regret it on the Day of Judgment, and I mean you will regret it for perverting the Word. Remember, Satan came to Jesus one day and said, "It is written, it is written."

And Jesus said, "It is also written."

Boy I got my neck in a sling years ago, as I told you, a bunch of Branhamites sitting around, and I said, "Yeah," I said, "You guys," I said, "You make me sick. [] All the time, you're looking down the road or looking back; never looking what's going on now." I said, "Do you know one thing? You quote Bro. Branham all the time, but Satan came one day and said to Jesus, 'It is written.' And he said, 'It's also written.' And you say Bro. Branham said it, and I say he also said."

Oh, oh I was the skunk at the garden party. [Laughter] Well I never did like garden parties, so who gives a rip.

- 50. He says in here, in 1 Cor [15:] 28,
 - (28) When all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also be subject unto him that put all things under him, that God may be all in all.

And this is speaking of the fact that this hour God is putting everything under the feet of Jesus, in this very hour. That's what you're looking at. Exactly, the New Jerusalem, the whole picture. And that's what I say is the body part, but I could misunderstand. I don't believe I have. There's nothing can add there.

51. Now we're going back to the Scripture for a little bit. We don't have too much time. But Bro. Branham here, now, as I've outlined to you, is telling you there are two types of people in the Bible. They constitute one lump called humanity. One is the seed of God, and one is the seed of the serpent; not the seed of the devil, as though the devil could have seed, but the devil got the beast there, the creation of God, to intermingle his seed with Eve, which could even produce a race; though hybrids usually don't produce, and they can't produce. They become sterile. And you get that in grains and everything else. But, all right, they were so close they could produce.

So therefore, that's why at the end time it's called brute—"natural, brute beasts, made to be taken and destroyed." And so we know there's a beast people. And a beast people are like us on the grounds that humanity, to begin with, Adam and Eve, were mammals. They could produce and breast-feed. They were mammals. And so the flesh got together, as Bro. Branham categorically said, "The virgin birth is nothing as to being problematical, compared to the normal birth of an ordinary child of God," because you've got in the male ejaculate, literally trillions of living sperm. And the women have cilia, like little eggs in there like little cilia (actually 250,000 not cilia, actual eggs) but beyond that a formation of cilia-like things which could produce millions of eggs.

So here is one man and woman, if they could get together and breed, could produce maybe a trillion kids. Now put that in five billion people. What kind of a mind has God got to trace His life to come forth in human beings in one lump, when you consider the male ejaculate of an animal could be far greater than a man's? Man alive. That's why I've often said, "The computer mind of God." And that is an insult to God. No computer built, to fill this earth, could ever take the mind of God.

- 52. So all right, you're looking at this mixed multitude, like that went out of Egypt going to the promised land, and God had to kill off everybody that was over twenty years of age, so there's a new product coming in, procreating, and bringing in children to the Millennium. It took forty years, and the Bride has wandered for forty years almost already. We're going onto thirty-four, just within a few months, six months.
- 53. Now Bro. Branham talking about this one who would have to be of such a superior quality that enable to redeem, and He has to redeem us. And the life given then, by Him, infinite, would take care of ours. Now he said:
- [73a] We find out in that great turmoil of the day, the people about understanding God, "God in three persons?" God, it's three attributes of God, like three

offices: God above us, in the Holy Spirit, and the Pillar of Fire; God made flesh and dwelt among us, and a Man that we could touch and handle;

Now notice he said, "God above us, Holy Spirit, in the Pillar of Fire." And yet time after time Bro. Branham said back in 1955, "The Pillar of Fire, the light, I came from God, go back," and it sounded just like it was Elohim Himself, and became like the Son, so that the Son was Elohim, and Elohim was the Son. It doesn't work brother/sister. It doesn't work. You've got to have your theme right. The theme is: the light came from God. That was the Son. And the end time, Pillar of Fire above the throne and the Lamb on the throne, and the Lamb is a body. So you've got Father and Son and all the other kids and all the other creation. That's it. You do what you want about it. I'm hated for it, and you will be too, but that's your business. If you don't want to get hated, just become Jesus-Only, Trinitarian, and who gives a rip. I mean, I can't do anything for you. See? Only God can, and only God will, if you're seed. See?

54. [73b] Now God in the Church. God above you; God with you; God in you. The same God, in three different manifestations, but the same God all the time.

Well, how much of God is in each one of us? Well, John's got God. His wife's got God. I've got God. My wife's got God. And Mae's got God. And Henry's got God. "Oh, hey, where's God? Well, I'd sooner you chose me, I'm God."

Is that how it goes? Come on brother/sister. Come on, come on. The great fount... Oh man alive. But you cannot reason and be fallacious. You've got to listen to the truth, and you build on what is the accurate truth. And everything is measured by the truth, which is doctrine.

55. [74a] Notice, to be no mistake. His sinless nature expressed God's Word.

All right. "His sinless nature." What is nature? There by birth. What was there by birth? Absolutely sinless. Couldn't be otherwise. He was born with it. He never acquired it. He never prayed to the Father to get it. How many of you prayed to your parents?

You say, "Now Mamma, I'm going to come forth in one month. I want blue eyes, don't forget, and I want great, beautiful bulging muscles. I'm a male that's going to be a powerful weightlifter. Schwarzenegger is going to look like peanuts along side of me."

Forget it. You're born, and that's the way you are. And any parent that has children coming, prays, "Oh God, I don't care what it is, male or female, and I don't care what it looks like, just make him healthy or her healthy, and a good brain." Even that prayer can go unanswered. Oh, if you've got diabetes, you'll have diabetic kids almost, but I'm not saying it couldn't go unanswered. God could do something about that, because He's the God of the universe.

56. [74b] His sinless Nature expressed God's Word.

So therefore, if he hadn't been born a certain way, the expression could not have been there concerning God's Word. So, if that's the way he was, and we're his younger children—younger brothers and sisters, or the little ones--we're going to have to be born a certain way too, or God's Word isn't going to have much influence period.

[74c] And the only way you will ever be able to express God's Word, that you believe It and watch It act behind you, and you have to have that sinless Nature that came from God.

And he tells you right here, if you're not like Jesus coming from God--in other words you're born a certain way--you're out of luck. So who's he preaching to? Preaching to seed the same as Paul was, and trying to clear the issues--same like the Galatians.

[74d] And before the foundation of the world, you were recognized with Him. Before the Word can ever express itself through you, it takes a sinless Nature to do that.

In other words you've got to be born with something, and that nature's sinless. And what did John say, "That which is seed of God cannot sin." You've got to have something... What is sin? It's unbelief. And what is unrighteousness? Acting on unbelief. And righteousness is acting on belief, correct belief.

- 57. Now the seed of God can't sin, so if you're not born seed, you're out of luck. And if you're born seed; you're in luck. "Well Bro. Vayle, I don't know, things are kind of funny, things are kind of funny." I know, you're funny too. I'm not saying phony; it was the funny-ness. Let's go to 2 Cor 5:14.
 - (14) For the love of Christ constrains us; because we thus judge, that if one man died for all, then were all dead:
 - (15) And (if) he that died for all, that they which live should not live henceforth unto themselves, but unto him which died for them, and rose again. (Now that's simple. He died for us so we ought to live for him.)
 - (16) Wherefore henceforth know we no man after the flesh: yea, though we have known Christ after the flesh, yet now henceforth know we him no more. (In other words, what he did was a past act, go beyond the past act.)
 - (17) Therefore if any man be in Christ, (now there you are, born again) he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

(18) And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given us the ministry of reconciliation;

Now it tells you right there, that if this isn't of God, it doesn't work. What he's talking about has to be of God. What he's talking about here, the rebirth, and the living for Christ; has to be of God, period, or you haven't got it. All of it's of God. All of it's of God. All of it's of God. Salvation. So if you weren't a part of God, you can't be redeemed. You can't be bought back. You haven't got it.

This is true predestination, which people do not understand, not even the great Arthur Pink. Not even Pink, who was the best of the whole bunch, and I've had the books. He could not understand and see a part of God. All he could see was humanity, and God foreknowing. He got that far then God making a way and God doing it. But as far as I recall, I have never read anybody who truly understood seed. In other words, that which issued forth from God Himself and took a form, because that's what seed is. And that tells you the truth.

Was it the egg first or the chicken? Well, if there hadn't been a chicken, there wouldn't be an egg. Something has to be there to produce a seed! And seed within itself, the life, is invisible, being spirit, a form. Now you have to have chemicals to produce the form for that life. And Mary produced the chemicals in her body, and that life within her took on the life of a human being. That's why Bro. Branham said, "God's the first man, Jesus is second, Adam the third." You find first man, first Adam, second Adam; first man, last man; or vice versa, I forget which it is. But there it is always in Scripture.

- (19) To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself,
- 59. There It tells you: God was in Christ. Doing what? Reconciling the world of the believers, His own World, unto Himself. And who are they? The seed, the reprobates, the rejected ones. Cain was rejected. Right? Then every serpent seed is rejected. Reprobates! And everybody that's not a reprobate has the life of God in him. He's a seed, "Because you are sons God sends forth His spirit to you." The one that died, shed forth his spirit, having risen again, "I will come. My Father will come," certainly, because it's the spirit. Jesus' spirit is God's Spirit, but it's not the whole Spirit. It's only part of it. He's that Son. That's not hard to understand. At least I don't think it is.
- 60. (19) To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. (In other words we get up and simply preach what God did. That's why Paul said, "I'm free from the blood of all men.")
 - (20) Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be reconciled to God.

God's reconciled to you, why are you mad at God? He's not mad at you. He's happy, He's reconciled, peace has been accomplished. Everything—everything is open. The banquet's spread. Come on.

"I don't like this, I don't like that."

They're like a little kid I used to have around me, a cute little fellow, Ralph ...?..., down there in ...?..., Alberta, and I used to put him on a broom and ride him around. He loved me.

And one day, he was sitting at the table, and he says, "I don't want any. I don't like it." "What is it?"

He didn't know what he was looking at, but he didn't like it. He didn't want it. So the rest of us ate, then pretty soon he got to eating. Boy, you know, well, that's life. That's life.

61. [75a] So much, till, he was the Word in full. The Word of God flowed through him so freely, he could even speak a word, it would create.

Look at the beauty here, "Oh, oh, this one, he got to a certain place now, he worked himself up and what he did, you know, he worked himself in to this particular position." Now there's a little Scripture for that, "That though he were a Son he learned obedience by suffering." I'm not discounting that for one minute. But I'm going to tell you, he's talking about nature, what he's born with.

He was born with this nature. He was born in a certain way that the Word of God could entirely flow through him, so that he could say a Word of God and create, providing that Word of God was the Word to flow through him. Yes, yes, yes, he didn't say, "Now Word of God flow through me, and I'll create. Now Word of God do this, and flow through me, and I'll do this."

That's serpent seed! That's those that come, "Oh, did we not cast out devils? Did we not prophesy? Did we not do miracles?"

"Yes," he said, "But you're rejected."

You've got to be born. Bro. Branham said, "Everybody doesn't pray for the sick."

"Well I'm in there to do it, I'm going to be a big show."

Yeah. Forget it. That ministry's not what you think it is brother/sister. I've been through it.

"He would create..." Sure if it was flowing through him. If the Word of God flowed through Bro. Branham, at that particular time, he said, "Let there be a squirrel," there'd be a squirrel. But I'll tell you what I saw, and I know he didn't say it. I stood there and watched the Word of God, and I'll tell you time and time after time, he had the microphone cord around him and Billy Paul said, "Now Lee, don't you ever dare let that microphone get around Daddy's, feet, and tangle up anything. He hates that thing." And I was sitting there like this, in Florida, and sitting there bug-eyed. And he picks up a chair, whirls around, "Oh God," here's all around him. "Now Lee, don't let that get around Daddy's feet." So cautiously I pulled, and it goes right around his ankles.

Now you know the law of the fulcrum. If I'm standing here, my ankles together, no boxer ever does it--one clip and he's gone. He stands like this. And here was William Branham, one push and he's gone. And I said, "Oh God." And I looked at that in horror, and I didn't blink one eye, and within a part of a second, that cord was no longer around his ankles, it was right by his feet. That cord had not moved, and he hadn't of...

"Well, Brother Vayle, oh but..."

Oh, shut up! I'll punch your unbelieving nose in and pull out your lying tongue and wrap it around your throat. Here's a Bible open, unless I am deceived, this Bible open before me, knowing there is a God in heaven. I had to see that or it was some hallucination, something apart from me, beyond Lee Vayle. No way, shape, and form. The Word of God flows through under conditions.

Now no Word of God flowing through me, no-no, I was in total unbelief. Total terror. No-no. The Word of God flowing through that man. [I] didn't blink an eye, but there it was. That to me is just as great as creation, but that's what I needed, because creation, to me, doesn't seem the same as that. I don't know, I've got to be my way, you've got to be your way. But you see...

63. [74e] Before the Word of God can express itself through you, it takes a sinless nature to do that.

Now let's go back to the fact of the Word of God expressing through you, and the Word of God says, "Behold, I'm going to send my Son, born by a virgin, and he is going to die upon Calvary's cross,

and His Blood shed upon the earth is going to redeem the people and His life is going to water the people that are in drought and they're going to bring them back to me." If you aren't a part of God, that Word cannot flow through you. In plain English, although it's there, it will never be expressed in you. You will never receive the baptism with the Holy Ghost.

Don't try to make this some big thing where, "Oh, the Word of God's going to flow through me. I'm going to pray, and I'm going to fast." And one fellow said years ago, his name was Ham, down there in Florida, and we were latter rain at that time and he said, "God is revealed to me, I'm going to have a bigger ministry that Oral Roberts." Phht — big... He never got off the ground. Another guy came to my church, his name was Harper, and after Bro. Branham was there, he said, "Bro. Vayle," he said, "Lord's revealed to me I'm going to have a greater ministry than Bro. Branham." He said, "I want you to rent me the arena down there that Bro. Branham had."

And I said, "Son, why don't you just come to my church and preach a little bit and we'll see?" Hah! [Laughter] Oh brother.

Years later, he met me in Boston, he said, "Bro. Vayle, I want to apologize." I said, "That's ok, brother, I know all about it." I wasn't—I wasn't fit to wash Bro. Branham—to wash Bro. Branham's feet or polish his shoes and I had a ministry that eclipsed that guy's so far there was no ministry... he didn't have any. A nice guy though, he was all right.

But if you weren't predestinated to it as a seed, that day will come he'll say, "I never knew you." See because the spirits on the outside of the soul, you can get anointed.

64. [76a] No other nature could do this. No other type of birth could do it. No other nature. No character, nothing in the Heavens, nothing else, could do that but Him, for He was in the beginning of the Character, Saviour! The Angel wasn't born a Saviour; He was created being to worship God, not a Saviour. But God was a Saviour. An ordinary man of an ordinary woman couldn't be Saviour, because that's nature's car—that nature is carnal. But it took the nature... but it took God Himself! Amen. I hope you see it. Look, that was the expression, (that's Logos, maybe, there, that was the expression.) to manifest such a character as that.

In other words that man, Christ Jesus, actually displayed because of his nature, the character. And the word 'character' comes from the word meaning 'to engraved upon'. So when he came in to this earth here, there was a nature that God could actually engrave upon and bring this person forth, perfect, what God wanted. And that's the way with you and me. But we get into sin. But Jesus never

did. He took obedience even unto death. You and I fight it. So therefore, there's a big discrepancy. But now we see the perfection here that Bro. Branham is talking about.

65. [76b] For others, it was a fallen character, nothing could save. Angels weren't created for such. Man was a fallen character.

In other words man was there as this nature of God, to receive it, but he let the carver become the enemy, Satan, and began carving upon him and directing him through his senses like Eve, and began working upon him. And the character did not come out commensurate with what lay between. No, never came out. Commensurate with Jesus. That's a different story... did. "My righteous servant," couldn't put a finger on him, see? Prophets failed, everybody failed, not Jesus.

[77a] Look, to show it's the one's he thought of, his thoughts, are the Christians of the... of today, (He's telling the Pentecostals and everybody.) that the thoughts before the foundation of the world...

Well, we had better be there before the foundation. Why? Because we came out of the dirt. Dirt doesn't produce life. It has qualities that sustain life. These idiots that talk about, "Oh, there might be some life on Mars because we found... spectroscopes and all, likely protein."

Bro. Branham made the perfect word, he said, "Before there was a fish with a fin to swim there was water to swim in." And certainly before there's a human being on Mars, there's going to be food to sustain him. What jackasses these people are? And they mouth off, "We are so superior. We are scientific. And the Scriptures never proven scientific. And what we say is right and..." I already told you, it would take trillion times trillion times trillion times trillion times trillion years to produce what's on this earth right now by evolution. Oh God, if there's not a God. Oh brother/sister, judgment has set in the earth. The thrones are all set up on earth, and nobody even knows it. It's all over.

Say we... I know the stock market didn't go down. They did what I thought they might do. So I told you, unless they pull a trick, the stock market's gone. What did they do? They pumped in money, more money; they turned the crank. That's what Mr. Greenspan did. And the whole bunch of them, they just turned the crank and turned the crank--money. What's money? It's nothing, its just paper. And gold keeps going down. And the fact of the matter is, don't anybody worry. You need currency. You need a means of exchange. And what is the difference really if you can use money and fool them or gold, they're still going to fool them? But now the next question is: what if resources, that money can buy, begin to fail? Ah, then watch all hell break loose. It would be like Germany after the first world war: wheelbarrows full of money to buy one loaf of bread. And you couldn't get it.

66. All right. Look, you were in His thoughts.

[77b] Now remember, "Man, when he was born in sin, shaped in iniquity (What I quoted from David last night.) comes to the world speaking lies." (Now that's in the Bible, that's Bible, that's in Job.) Is that right? There's nothing in him at all. So, you see, if he was in God's thoughts when he came into the world, he's come (in God's thoughts at the beginning) to display his attributes.

In other words he's telling you again, man, of himself, is nothing, and that's the bunch out here. You have to have that spark from God. You have to have that life that was in the beginning – do you follow me?

67. [77c] Then Jesus came to break the clouds back, so that attribute could display itself. He is God's expressed Word. (As Bro. Branham said, "Every prophet had a part of the Word, to express it..." I'm sure he added... had that in mind, and then he said, "Jesus was the full Word." Right?) Now, nothing else could be manifested;

Well look it, a dog is a dog: "woof-woof, bark, bark, bark." He doesn't go "meow, meow, meow, meow, meow, meow, meow, meow" to fool another dog or a cat. It's that simple; it's that simple. A cow with a cloven hoof has a couple of stomachs. It chews its food, swallows, regurgitates, masticates it thoroughly, sends it down for nourishment. Because it's a cow – what do you expect? God in continuity, what would you... what could there be other than this one? See?

Dr. Jensen's a very remarkable man, he could have died recently, in his nineties, I guess, or eighties, whatever it is, nineties. He had cancer, everything else, absolutely cured. He was on the lecture tour again. He's traveled the whole world, he said, "I've seen every religion. I've seen it all. There's only one can qualify; that's Christianity, with Jesus Christ as Savior." But you say, "Well he's not a scientist, he's a chiropractor, and he's an eye chemist..." In other words he's not a jackass, so don't listen to him, you know; bigmouth.

68. [77d] *Other characters had fallen.*

Why? Because what was engraven upon them couldn't hold the test. Jesus had to be by nature and engraving, in order to be that person to save us. And nobody else has it; nobody else, because even though you're born again, you still cannot qualify. You will die and you'll stay there unless you have somebody to pick you up, having paid the price. Now that's what Bro. Branham is telling you here. Now,

- [77e] No, no, they were born in sin, shaped in iniquity.
- [78a] He came as Redeemer. And to 'redeem' anything means to "bring it back." Amen. Bring it back! It was God's thoughts, you! Think! Little me, big me; no one else in the world (qualifies and so on) could take my place, nobody can take yours. You being a Christian and filled with the Spirit, God, before the foundation of the world, saw you and knew every feature that you have, see, (He knows what you look like) and Jesus came to bring you back. That's what Jesus was here for, Redeemer, the human body, to bring you back.

Now he's telling you what's going to come back: the human body. Would it get you out of the grave? The Holy Ghost seals you in for the day of redemption, which is resurrection. And now God Himself has to come down and raise the dead. And He's down here now with the shout. And when the shout is thoroughly manifested, which means the Church, the Bride, in true subjection to God, the dead will come up, that would be a Rapture. That's Bible. That's "THUS SAITH THE LORD." The Bride was waiting for the revelation of the rapture. She got it in December 4 out there in Yuma, Arizona, in 1965.

69. [78b] That's what Jesus was here for, Redeemer, the human body, to bring you back. That had to come to—that had to come to be a human, as a Redeemer, to display His attributes as Saviour, come to redeem you and bring you back from where you came from.

Now why is that so? Because that's what God wanted. Say, "Well why should He have a Redeemer, why did God ...?... shed blood, why did ...?..., why, why this?" Because that's God wanted and He vindicated it so shut up and sit down and stay sat down before you get your head knocked off. That's a good thing too; don't get your head knocked off.

There's a guy, who taking his training, I read in Reader's Digest, and he was so... six-foot-six, and the obstacle course, he could never... All they ever saw was his—was his hind-end coming up, he kept his... he had to get his head down. And the guy in control said one thing, he said, "Sergeant I know this," he said, "You will never be shot in the head." [Laughter] Why stick your head up and get shot? Why be some kind of a fool? Bend your head in humility and say, "God said so, this is what God said, and it's vindicated." Look, I've got nothing to do with this. It's so far beyond me that God had to bring His Own Son in here, this Only-Begotten One, to take care of my sins and God raised him, fully satisfied, and now He's taking care of me. So that's grace. Got it from God, redeemed by God, back to God. And then the privilege of serving Him, getting rewards – grace. Well, if that's not grace, I don't know what grace is.

70. [79] When you receive Eternal Life, there is only one form of Eternal Life. That's the Greek word 'Zoe'. Is that right? (Well sure it's right, but it... it's not right. In the Bible, Zoe is the highest form of... referring to God, that's true. But you get the word 'Zoe'. you get Zoology. So Okay.) God's Own life."

When it refers to God, 'zoe' refers to God. It's just like the word in the... same in the Greek, God can be magistrate or mister. But when you're referring to the person that you know in the book, then you give it the high order. You know, it's all you can do. And I like it anyway because this is associates us with God and it associates God with all life around us. It's really beautiful when you come to think of it. Like Bro. Branham said, "You've seen God in nature."

[79b] Zoe, "God's Own Life." So you, being a son, you became part of that life. (You were part of that life) So the life that's in you never did begin and never can end. Think of it, it can't end because that's anything eternal never began. And the life that's in you never did begin. That is, if you've got eternal life. And that's God, and you were in His thoughts on the eternal. In other words, you were part of the whole scheme of God's eternality, of God's Own eternality. And now it's expressed here in a human

being for His glory. Jesus came to redeem that, being the Son, the fullness of God had to come and become that. Now you see, God gets glorified in Jesus, Jesus gets glorified, God gets glorified in us, and we get glorified. Process of glorification. The sinless character of God did that, that he might redeem those other thoughts that—that were to come to Him, to make a wife. See what I mean? Oh, it's a glorious story! We oughtn't to get on that anyhow.

Let's go on. All right.

- [80] Notice, God created. God flowed through him just like the wind flows through a building, or water flows downstream, even had him and the Word being one. No other character could do that.
- 71. Now you notice he talks about, first of all, nature, and now he says character. And that's exactly true, because Jesus positively was the living Word. Nothing left out, nothing added. Complete manifestation--Almighty God's Word. And that was the life engraving itself in that person. And that's all He allowed to engrave him. When Satan says, "Cast yourself down." He said, "It's written, 'you don't tempt the Lord God.' I'm going this way. This is what God wants."

"Well turn the rocks into bread."

He said, "Come on, hold it." He said, "forget it. I don't live by that kind of sustenance. I've got the Word of God to live by."

"Well come on," he said, "do this to that."

He said, "No, no, no, the Word of God's against it."

Here's a man that lived by the Word. That was his engraving. And we get engraved with the Word and that's what I call practicing and getting in the habit, and there's a special word in the Bible where it says, about the fact, when man gets into sin, he learns by the processes. And also, you come to reasoning in righteousness. So that by the time that God is working with us, and we deliberately sow that Word of God, we see the positive results, we shy from the negative, like a child that knows a hot stove is going to burn him, having been burned. That's where your character comes from, the engraving. The nature which you're born with is there, but it must be engraved, and that's where you feed your soul, the Christ within you, the Word of Life and say, "That's what I live by. That's what I practice." Oh man, we're a bunch of... Well, let's not talk about that. Let's talk about the positive. See? Now, he says here,

- [80b] No character to do it, for he was the only One that was born without carnality. All the rest of them were sexual desires were carnal. He was born without sex desire, he was virgin born.
- 72. Now, what you got to in the garden there, it's children became born by sexual desire rather than the Spirit of God directing, because that's how it was supposed to be all done, and so you had a problem there. What... .) Okay. Now watch:
- [80b] God... men were born by sexual desire.

See, that's the bad feature right there. That's why the races propagated were like animals even though we have to be taught it, procedures and prospects and all. Animals don't. It's a desire, and it's terrible.

[81a] God identified Himself as we are. He took His strain, (Now the 'strain' means 'specie, ancestry, lineage, descent, descendants of a common ancestry.' So God then took one of us, which was of Him) His strain was God and stretched His tent down here to become human. He made Himself a tent, a body to live in, that body came... was known as Jesus. God lived in Jesus.

Well God lived in Jesus Christ. What it Christ? Christ means Messiah. So what is it? God lived in Messiah, thereby becoming Messiah to the world and yet sharing with Jesus. See? He was supposed to be that one. Christ was the Blood of God, and his Name was Jesus. Jesus is the Name of the Father: big Jehovah, little Jehovah. See?

- [81b] He became human, in order to save us. And he took upon him our form, that he might mold us in His character.
- 73. In other words, having gone ahead of us, given us the spirit commensurate now to the spirit body, if we live that... want that Word, that Word can actually engrave upon us the Word of Almighty God so that we now are living Spirit Word. And you're not going to be involved in the sins of the world.

Now we're going to have problems, and we will sin, backslide a thousand times a day, sin a thousand times a day. But there there's the only hope for the engraving and the coming forth with greater glory.

[82a] And his character was that he did everything that pleased God and he stayed with the Word. And that's what he molded us for, to stay with God's Word, find our place, and then know where we're at and stay with His Word!

And the Bible warns us, "Stay in the place where God has you, unless He's called you to minister or something else." If you move, you move for the sake of the Word. All of these things are Word, Word, Word.

74. I wish I had another couple hours here, because I could really get into some good thinking. But, it doesn't matter; I can leave my thinking alone. So all right, we're going to have conclude here, and I think it's a pretty good place to stop. And we can come back, if we ever do get back, to where we find us coming into the image of Christ, which he was the image of God, it's all part and parcel of the same thing, which actually means the living Word of God is manifested.

So all right, we can rise at this time and be dismissed. [] Let's bow our heads.

Heavenly Father, having been in Your Presence and stood with You here, Lord, knowing that You are here upon earth and You're bringing a Bride to perfection. And knowing, Lord God, that we have narrowed it right down to where the prophet narrowed it down. And knowing that You spoke in and through him, God in the prophets, we know we have Your Word here today, that this is a message for the Bride even as Bro. Branham spoke concerning that not long before he left the earth when he brought, concerning the elder John to the elect lady, and we believe this message is to the elect lady. Also, those elect in You, Lord, the part of You.

And we know, Father, that this is the thing that the devil has fought from the beginning. This is, of course, what the serpent seed makes light of and fights the understanding of serpent seed from the beginning. So therefore, we know the dispersion now falls upon all of us, how could any of us really claim to a source, You being that source, which even the Catholic church condemns to such an extent they call them heretics?

So here we stand, Lord, condemned by the Catholic people, whether they be Orthodox or Roman, the Protestants, whether they be Lutheran, this or that or the other thing, yet Luther knew, he understood predestination. All of these people, Lord, have gone back. They're out of men's minds entirely. Nobody seems to understand or have a knowledge, or even a desire or even worse, Father, a true appreciation of predestination, which means 'coming from You and going back to You', wherein Paul said, "It is great cause for rejoicing." How, Lord, the people do not rejoice, how they turn upon it, and we, ourselves, Lord, we admit that we do not rejoice in it sufficiently. Lord, what is wrong with us? If we need to be scalped as it were, if we need our brains to be dredged out and a new brain put in, if we lack a true baptism of our brains with the Holy Ghost, whatever it is Lord that we do not have...
