

Ordinance No. 628

An ordinance entitled an ordinance relating to the appointment, salary, and term of office, of certain officers ^{and their assistants} in the city of Garnett, Kansas.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Garnett, Kansas:

Sec. 1. ^{That} There shall be appointed in the City of Garnett, For a term ~~maxi~~ ~~imum~~ beginning on the 1st. day of May 1915, by the board of commissioners of said city, a City Clerk who shall receive for his services a salary of \$42.50 per month payable monthly.

Sec. 2. ^{That} There shall be appointed in the City of Garnett, for a term beginning on the 1st. day of May 1915, by the board of commissioners of said city, a City Treasurer, who shall receive a salary for his services of \$10.00 per month payable monthly.

Sec. 3. ^{That} There shall be appointed in the city of Garnett, for a term beginning on the 1st. day of May 1915. by the board of commissioners of said city, a City Attorney, who shall receive a salary for his services of \$10.00 per month payable monthly.

Sec. 4. ^{That} There shall be appointed in the city of Garnett, for a term beginning on the 1st. day of May 1915. by the board of Commissioners, a City Marshall, who shall receive for his services a salary of \$45.00 per month payable monthly.

Sec. 5. ^{That} There shall be appointed in the city of Garnett, for a term beginning on the 1st. day of May 1915. by the board of commissioners of said city, a Police Judge, who shall receive a salary of \$2.50 per month payable monthly.

Sec. 6. ^{That} There shall be appointed in the city of Garnett, for a term beginning on the 1st. day of May 1915. by the board of commissioners of said city, a Fire Chief, who shall receive a salary of \$2.00 for each time the Fire Department of said city shall be called to service, by a fire alarm in said city, said chief to be recommended, by the fire department of said city.

Sec. 7. ^{That} There shall be appointed in the city of Garnett, for a term beginning on the 1st. day of May 1915. by the board of commissioners of said city, a City Engineer who shall receive for his services a salary of \$3.⁰⁰ for each day he is employed by said city as such engineer.

Sec. 8. There shall be appointed in the City of Garnett, for services at the Waterworks ~~pumping~~ ~~stations~~ and Electric Light ~~Stations~~ stations at Crystal Lake, and Cedar Creek, a chief Engineer, who shall receive for his services a salary of \$62.50 per month payable monthly.

Sec. 9. There shall be employed from time to time such assistant engineers at said stations as may be required, to properly attend to the work thereat, who shall receive for their services a salary of \$50.00 per month during the ~~time~~ of their employment.

Sec. 10. There shall be appointed in the city of Garnett, for a term beginning on the 1st. day of May 1915. a Water works Superintendant, and a Street Commissioner, which two offices shall until otherwise provided for by ordinance, ~~will~~ be conducted and held by the same person, who shall receive for his services the sum of \$50.00 per month payable monthly \$20.00 from the Water works fund and \$30.00 from the Street Fund.

Sec. 11. There may be employed in the City of Garnett, by the Mayor such assistant City Marshalls, as may be required to keep the peace and order of said city, who shall receive a salary of \$1.50 per day for the time of their employment.

Sec. 12. There may be employed an assistant city clerk as occasion may require, who may perform the duties of the office of City Clerk, and who shall receive a salary of \$12.⁰⁰ per week during such employment.

Section 13 that there shall be appointed in the city of Garnett an Electrician for a term beginning on the first day of May 1915 who shall receive for his services a salary of \$ 52.00 per month payable monthly.

Section

Officers provided for in this ordinance shall hold their offices for a term of two years and until their successors shall be appointed and qualified as provided by law. and the assistant officers shall hold their positions during the time of their employment by the Mayor and board of commissioners.

Sec. 15. ~~This ordinance shall take effect from and after the time required by law after its passage and publication.~~ All Ordinances and parts *of ordinance* in conflict with this ordinance ^{that} are hereby repealed.

Sec. 16. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the time required by law after its passage and publication.
