MRSC Members,

We **ARE** having our June 13-14 show at the National Equestrian Center. **HOWEVER** due to the Covid 19 Phase One St. Charles County reopening requirements there are several rule/show changes. **PLEASE READ CAREFULLY THIS ENTIRE DOCUMENT!!!**

Phase One reopening requirements end on May 31. We are hoping to have the next phase requirements quickly following that date – but as of today we must follow the requirements that are currently in place.

1. **NO spectators allowed.**
2. Ranch classes or other specialty classes will **NOT** be offered.
3. Non showing horses are not allowed. To attend the horse/rider must show in a MINIMUM of 2 classes – excluding leadline.
4. Due to limited space ponying will not be allowed.
5. In Barn only **10 people** per row (each side of main aisle) will be allowed which will limit the total number of people attending the show. Each child can only have 1 adult/guardian with them during the show. Entire capacity of Arena B is 110 people which includes riders, trainers, show workers, judges & all other people (from the aisles) attending the show. **Nothing will be allowed on either end of the aisles – no muck buckets, hay bales, chairs etc.**
6. In Warmup Arena only **20 people** are allowed. This basically becomes a holding area for the next class and passing area for riders leaving existing class.
7. We are also renting the outdoor arena for the weekend to allow riders to ride and lunge their horses.
8. In case of inclement weather we will have Barn 5 for lunging and we have modified our showbill for allowing more riding breaks – see attached. Riders may ride before the show starts in the show arena and during the riding breaks.
9. We are changing our stall reservation procedure. Everyone requesting a stall must fill out the attached stall reservation form and send WITH A CHECK to the address on the form. If you are unable to attend you will need to notify the show manager immediately however **STALLS ARE NON REFUNDABLE.**
10. Due to the new requirements we will need to limit the number of people attending the show. In order to do this MEMBERS FROM THE LAST 2 YEARS will be given “first come first serve” priority for attending the show. **Members have until May 31 to send in their stall reservations.**
11. If you have not been a member within the last two years and would like to attend our show you will need to send in your stall reservation as soon as possible along with a check. You will be added “first come first serve” to a waiting list. If you are notified that we are unable to accommodate your stall request your check will be returned to you.
12. **Memberships for 2020** the onetime Weekend Membership has been eliminated. **Everyone must pay a full membership.** Updated membership forms will be emailed to everyone within the next couple of weeks. Paperwork MUST be received before attending the show.

13. **Horse nominations for 2020 cost \$60.** Minimum attendance for shows has been eliminated. Double point shows are July and August. Forms will be emailed to everyone within the next couple of weeks. Paperwork MUST be received before attending the show.
14. **Class registration – MUST** be received no later than June 10th. You may enter via the online form on our website or via fillable pdf that will be emailed to you within the next couple of weeks.

We as the MRSC board/officers are committed to bringing you the best show season during these challenging times. We will keep you updated on any show changes as soon as we are aware. We thank you for your continued support.
