The Town Council met July 3, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. in the Thorsby Municipal Annex Building.

Mayor Hight reported to the Council there are a lot of ditches that need to be cleaned out. The equipment that Terry will need will be around \$1500 to \$1900.00 a month. He stated

he did not need a vote on this right now just wanted the Council to know it would need to be done in the future.

Mayor Hight reported to Council they have a letter in their packets from Butterfly Bridges asked the Council to put them back in the budget for this next year.

Council Member Littleton asked about the leaks Terry had been working on. Mayor Hight stated there was 2 8in mains on Co Rd 231 and Co Rd 44.
