Evaluation and Placement Information

Player evaluations will be held in February 2019. The goal of the evaluations is for players to be placed at the levels where they can best play, develop, and have fun. These are not "try outs" – all players are accepted and placed.

Evaluation and Placement Requirement:

- **Softball**: Any child who was not on a major league (or higher) softball team last season **must attend the evaluation to be considered for softball minor or major league play.** A child must be at least 7 years old by 12/31/18 **and** be in the 1st Grade or higher to play softball. Anyone who played on a Ridgefield softball team last year at the major league level does not need to attend an evaluation this year.
- **Baseball:** Any child who was not on a major league (or higher) baseball team last season **must attend the evaluation to be considered for minor league or major league play.** A child must be at least age 7 (by 8/31/19) to be eligible for minor league play and at least age 9 (by 8/31/19) to be eligible for major league play. However, **meeting the age requirement does not guarantee that a child will be placed on a minor or major league team**. Placement will depend on the evaluation. Anyone who played on a Ridgefield major league (or higher) baseball team last year does not need to attend an evaluation this year.

Evaluation Dates and Times:

Sunday, February 10, 2019 at Ridgefield Memorial High School Gym

Softball – 12:00 Noon Baseball – 1:00 p.m.

Wednesday, February 13, 2019 at 7:00 at Ridgefield Memorial High School Gym (make-up evaluation for players who miss 2/10/18 evaluation)

Registrations:

You can register in person at the evaluations. However, if you do not register by February 1, 2018, your child may be placed on a waiting list. Also, you must register ONLINE before November 30, 2018 to receive the \$10 early registration discount.

Year End:

Our closing ceremony will take place 11am September 7th 2019 at the Five Fireman's Field. All are invited to the awards presentation as well as for free hot dogs, burgers and drinks.
