• Bill Creed – Said that when there had been a previous discussion regarding the triangle shaped property below the former Seehorn property, the Town of Rockford refused to take liability of water service lines running through private property.

81 COUNCIL REPORTS

- Mrs. Harnois reports that the Deputy Mayor of Spokane Valley is pushing for CDBG committee support of our Well Project.
- Mrs. Harnois will confirm the Town of Rockford's Water Rights status in light of a new Bill being brought before the State Legislature.
- Mrs. Harnois received an invoice from the parent company of URS for \$930.00 sent last March to the Town for services rendered pertaining to the Shoreline Master Plan. Rockford has no indication of receipt of this invoice, nor does the Department of Ecology. Per Mayor Roecks, an e-mail from Jeremy Sykes indicated that the project was closed in June, and there is no reason that this company should be billing the Town of Rockford. Rockford will not pay this bill.
- Mayor Roecks said that Well Project Engineering won't be paid from CDBG funds, and costs can be incurred for other aspects of the project.
- Mr. Benson said that he is looking into grants pertaining to rural community security/surveillance systems as well a tracking tag technology information to share with our agricultural community.

96 APPROVE CHECKS

Ocuncil was requested to sign past Warrant Registers where checks were approved and signed, but signatures were not obtained.

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A Check was requested for payment of Department of Ecology's "Dam Safety Review". The dam Review pertains to Lagoon Number 3. A dam payment of \$1900 has been sent, and an additional \$358 because their review took longer than they expected.

Mr. Stevenson made a motion to approve payment of \$383.00 to DOE for the dam review. Mr.
 Thompson seconded. Motion was carried.

Mr. Stevenson made a motion to approve checks 13281 through 13291 for \$4451.14. Mr. Thompson seconded. Motion was carried.
