2. Review/ Approve meeting minutes

A motion was made and Selectmen voted 3-0 to approve March 29, 2016 meeting minutes and warrant.

3. New Business

◦ **Calderwood Engineering – Open Dearborn Road Bridge Bids**

◦ **Hearst Television Abatement Application** - Received abatement from Hearst Television. Selectmen recommended to forward to John O'Donnell Associates for review and recommendation.

◦ **Review Tyco Estimate for Garage Security**- Need to verify the price and confirm that the security system recommended includes video surveillance.

◦ **Boston Cane – Wednesday 4/13/16 at 1pm** – The Boston Cane will be dedicated to Mrs. Wood. All three Selectmen will attend.

◦ **Cemetery Maintenance** – Discussion on cemetery maintenance this year. Need to check with insurance company if mowing equipment can be hauled behind a personal vehicle. Selectmen voted to stay within the \$9,000 cemetery budget.

◦ **School Roof Leak**- At least get ¾ bids on the roof leak repair. Selectmen voted 3-0 to contact contractors and provide specs to all contractors.


6. Adjournment
