- **5** Game management needs are arranged for.

- 6 Facility improvements or repairs have been requested and scheduled.
- 7 You have attended any meetings that cover new rules.
- 8 You have fulfilled your league duties, such as responsibilities for overseeing a particular sport.
- 9 Parent nights have been scheduled and publicized.
- **10** Coaches meetings are scheduled and planned out.
