Course Description

The student having already attained basic coding or medical billing skills will focus on case studies to determine diagnoses and procedure coding utilizing ICD-10-CM CPT and HCPCS. Students will be exposed to medical records and learn how to interpret actual charts. The student will adhere to coding regulations and guidelines in code assignments and ensure accuracy of diagnoses and procedure coding.

Course Goals:

1. Apply official coding guidelines when coding cases
2. Assign diagnoses and procedure codes on complex case studies
3. Utilize medical records charts to code diagnoses and procedures
4. Sit for CPC certification exam/Earn CPC designation

Course Objectives:

1. Increase medical terminology knowledge
2. Correctly apply ICD-10-CM
3. Correctly apply CPT and HCPCS
4. Understand coding guidelines and apply those rules and regulations when coding cases
5. Understand documentation requirements and be able to articulate the discrepancies between coded data and supporting documentation
6. Utilize medical records charts to assign diagnoses and procedures
7. Understand coding compliance strategies, auditing, monitoring and reporting
