Place only clean green in your yardwaste can:

- Grass clippings
 - Weeds
- Brush and branches; bermuda grass okay
- Vegetable peelings, fruit and vegetables including pumpkins, carrot peels, broccoli stems, lettuce, apple cores and peels, etc.
- Wood ashes (cold), Paper plates & napkins (non-coated)
- Prunings maximum 4' long and 11/2" in diameter, Christmas trees cut to fit in container (no flocking, tinsel, decorations or stand)

These are not allowed in your yardwaste can:

- Garbage
- Compostable bags
- Compostable paper or Wood products or products

- Palm Fronds
- Meat, Bones and Dairy

- Leave three (3) feet space between containers.
- All yardwaste must be inside container. Loose material will not be collected.
- Do not put yardwaste in plastic bags.
