Artist Demonstration

On June 17th at our WOWS meeting, join Rhonda Sloan for a watercolor demo focused on capturing the rustic beauty of barns, farm scenes, and cows. With an emphasis on creating atmosphere, Rhonda will demonstrate how to use soft washes, muted color, and selective detail to bring mood and storytelling into rural landscapes. Learn how to suggest weathered wood, open fields, and the gentle presence of grazing cows—all



without overworking the scene. Rhonda's loose, expressive technique allows the subject to breathe, inviting the viewer into a peaceful, familiar setting full of charm and character.
