Darwin Gilger stated that he felt that the District should get in contact with the Grand County Commissioners and ask them to adopt the State Plumbing Code. David J. Bretzke is to call Bobbie Domenick and ask that this item be put on the agenda for the Grand County Commissioner's next meeting.

A Motion by Neal Dalton and seconded by Dan Holyoak to approve STRATTON BROS. the contract for \$969,250.00 bewteen SVW&SID and Stratton Brothers for the proposed sewer project. MOTION CARRIED.

David J. Bretzke stated to the Board of Trustees that the District cannot have a Loan Closing until there can be a transfer of money from F.H.A, to our Escrow Account.

David J. Bretzke stated to the Board of Trustees that we can award the bid but not a notice to proceed until after the Loan Closing.

David J. Bretzke stated that we need to have a pre-construction meeting the same day that we have the Loan Closing since all agencies will be here on February 22nd, 1983.

Harry Snow stated to the Board of Trustees that the easement for J.L. Carroll has been mailed to him. Harry Snow asked Dan Holyoak to appraise Paul Medley and Thomas Langford's property. Dan Holyoak suggested that he and Darwin Gilger travel to Pioche, Nevada and talk to Mr. Medley about his easement. The Board agreed to pay their expenses for this trip.
