Continue your exciting journey in Tanzania at the famous Serengeti National Park during the famous wildebeest river crossings on the Mara River. Serengeti National Park, recognized as a World Heritage Site, is one of the most famous wildlife areas in the world and is considered the world's oldest protected eco-system. The Serengeti is the largest national park in Tanzania, with a staggering animal population of almost four million and 523 recorded species of birds!

DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

DAY 1: MONDAY, JULY 30 2018
Depart for the Serengeti, explore the park
📍 Serengeti, Tanzania



Participants who choose this extension will fly today from Tarangire National Park to the NW Serengeti. Clients will be met upon arrival by private guides and vehicle and game drive today in the northern Serengeti.



The Serengeti is best known for its enormous herbivore migration, which is led by more than 1.5 million wildebeest and over 400,000 zebra. Their presence makes the Serengeti a fantastic smorgasbord for predators looking to fill their bellies, so keep your eyes peeled for a possible hunt. The Serengeti National Park is estimated to host about 70 types of large mammals and roughly 500 species of avifauna.



Spend the day exploring the game park with your guide and fellow travelers in small jeeps. Make sure you have your camera handy!

Check into your unique accommodations tonight at the Karibu River Camp.

DAY 3: WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 1 2018

Soak in more wildlife sightings as you travel to the Kogatende airstrip and fly back to Arusha, Tanzania, leaving late in the morning and arriving shortly after noon. ~~Drive back to Arusha arriving in time for a hot buffet lunch at the Arusha Coffee Lodge.~~

You will have a chance to visit the **Cultural Heritage Center** today which boasts beautiful ebony carvings and one of the largest selections of gemstones in Africa, including tanzanite—a rare, blue-violet stone found only in Tanzania. See and shop for other African art including: batiks, masks, jewelry, baskets, and local crafts.

Return to the African Tulip Hotel where you will have access to a dayroom. Enjoy a farewell dinner at the hotel this evening as you reminisce about your time in Tanzania.

Early evening transfer to the international airport for your return flight to the U.S.



DAY 4: THURSDAY, AUGUST 2 2018

Arrive back in New York today for your connecting flights home.

Ideally located only 320 yards from the famous Mara River, set amidst acacia trees and the whispering grasslands of northern Serengeti is River Camp. This 10-tented camp offers quick access to viewing the spectacular drama of the wildebeest river crossings during the long dry season months of July thru October. All year long the Mara River attracts numerous resident wildlife big and small such as large herds of elephant, eland and cape buffalo. Antelopes of many kinds also enjoy the higher elevation, cooler temperatures, and excellent grazing. Lions, leopards and cheetah maintain their territories throughout the year.
