Bloomfield Police Department Monthly Report for November 2018

This is the monthly report for the Month of November 2018 from the Bloomfield Police Department. It is the police department's goal to keep the citizens of Bloomfield Township/Village informed as to the police department's activities, statistics, and community projects. It is very important that the citizens be aware of the various concerns that have and are occurring within our community.

On Sunday, November 4th at approximately 12:51pm officers responded to a residence on Giles Drive for a criminal damage to automobile complaint. The complainant reported she discovered the sidewall on one of her vehicle tires had a "gash" causing approximately \$75.00 damage.

On Sunday, November 4th at approximately 9:02pm officers responded to a residence on Honeysuckle Road for a report of a fight. At the conclusion of the investigation, a 21-year-old male was issued a non-traffic citation for disorderly conduct.

On Sunday, November 4th at approximately 11:45pm officers executed a traffic stop on Pell Lake Drive in the area of Hwy U for a traffic infraction. At the conclusion of the traffic stop a 39-year-old male was issued traffic citations for failure/improper stop at a stop sign, operating after suspension and operating a motor vehicle without insurance.

On Tuesday, November 6th at approximately 4:32am officers attempted to execute a traffic stop on Hwy 50 for a speeding violation. The vehicle refused to stop which caused a pursuit into Kenosha County then was terminated at the Illinois state line. At the conclusion of the investigation a 38-year-old female was issued traffic citations for the speed violation and operating without a valid driver's license. Additionally, a charge of vehicle operator flee/elude a traffic officer was forwarded to the Walworth County District Attorney's office.

On Wednesday, November 7th at approximately 8:10am officers executed a traffic stop in the parking lot of the Mobil for a traffic infraction. At the conclusion of the traffic stop a 33-year-old male was issued traffic citations for non-registration of a motor vehicle, operating after suspension, operate motor vehicle without insurance, failure to wear seatbelt and operate motor vehicle without adequate muffler.

On Sunday, November 11^{th} at approximately 11:27pm officers executed a traffic stop on Daisy Drive in the area of Camelia Road for a traffic infraction. At the conclusion of the traffic stop a 22-year-old female was issued a non-traffic citation for disorderly conduct with a motor vehicle and possession of marijuana.

On Tuesday, November 13th at approximately 3:59pm officers responded to a residence on Myrtle Road for a restraining order violation complaint. At the conclusion of the investigation a 25-year-old male was arrested then confined in the Walworth County Jail. Charges of trespass to land and violation of a restraining order have been forwarded to the Walworth County District Attorney's office.

On Friday, November 23rd at approximately 8:15pm officers responded to the Mobil for a report of a hit & run traffic accident. At the conclusion of the investigation a 44-year-old male was issued traffic citations for hit & run property damage and duty to report accident.

On Tuesday, November 27^{th} at approximately 1:28pm officers responded to the area of Bloomfield Road and North Road for a personal injury crash. At the conclusion of the investigation a 50-year-old female was issued a traffic citation for driving too fast for conditions.

During the month of November 2018, the Bloomfield Police Department responded to 794 calls for service compared to 993 calls for service during the month of November 2017. During the month of November 2018, the police department affected 138 arrests for various violations of Bloomfield Municipal Ordinances and Wisconsin State Statutes compared 109 arrests during the month of November 2017.
