That is the meaning of God with Israel in the Old Testament and with Jesus in the New.



Assisting Ministers Needed

An **Assisting Minister** is responsible for assisting the presiding minister (usually the ordained pastor) with the worship service. This may include reading various prayers for the day and assisting the pastor with communion, baptisms, healing liturgies and occasionally reading of the lessons. An Assisting Minister may also, but not necessarily, serve at the prayer stations.

A Prayer Station Minister offers laying on of hands with special prayers to meet individual needs. Prayers are provided for those who prefer them to extemporaneous prayer. If you'd like to volunteer as an Assisting Minister and/or a Prayer Station Minister please let us know.

Would you like to assist with Communion?

Two of the three **Communion Assistants** deliver the wine, grape juice and bread to the altar immediately after the offering has been received. During communion you hold the chalice for drinking or intinction saying "The Blood of Christ shed for you" as worshipers commune.

Come early—Stay late

The church doesn't open & close itself. We need willing bodies for **Set-up & Clean-up**. Each group consists of at least two people who share various duties such as opening the sanctuary, moving various tables into position, making coffee, setting out refreshments, sweep-



ing the grounds, altar dusting, vacuuming, taking out the trash, kitchen clean-up, wiping down tables, locking up, etc.

Acolytes

Acolyte – "follower" and "helper." Our supply of Acolytes is dwindling. Any member of CLC at any age can be an Acolyte. The acolyte is responsible for lighting & extinguishing the candles, carrying the cross, distributing the offering bowls, and assisting with Holy Communion and Baptisms. The Acolyte's duties begin 15 minutes prior to the service.

If you are interested in being an acolyte please let us know. Pastor Keith will be training acolytes as interests are forth coming.

What does an Usher do?

Ushers distribute church bulletins, record attendance count, collect the offering, and direct people to the altar area for communion. Easy Cheesy!

Would you like to become a Reader?

From the lectern, the **Reader** speaks God's word from the Bible to the congregation by reading the scripture lessons of the day.
