

Vote by Mail 2019

All voters in the election jurisdiction receive a ballot in the mail after **October 9**. Either return it by mail, drop it off at a ballot center or collection site, or vote in-person at a ballot center or megasite.

Polling places will be replaced with ballot centers that are not precinct specific. Although all voters in the jurisdiction will get a ballot in the mail, voters can still choose to vote in-person at any ballot center or megasite.

Voters will have the option of voting in person 27 days, including the weekend before Election Day and on Election Day. Voters can vote in-person, request a replacement ballot or drop off their ballots at ballot centers.

It has been confirmed that one ballot center will be located on the property of our PVSchools district offices, **15002 N 32nd St, Phoenix, AZ 85032**. The hours it will be open are as follows:

October 28, 2019 – November 1, 2019 from 7:30 am – 4:30 pm

November 4, 2019 from 7:30 am – 4:30 pm

November 5, 2019 from 5:00 am – 9:00 pm
