

SC LIFE Scholarship recipients receive up to \$5,000 each academic year

LIFE Scholarship Enhancement, eligible sophomores, juniors and seniors may receive up to \$7,500 (\$5,000 LIFE Scholarship award combined with \$2,500 additional Enhancement funds). *Please note that LIFE Scholarship Enhancements are not available to students attending two-year institutions.*

In order to qualify for the LIFE Scholarship, first-time entering freshman attending an eligible four-year institution or technical school must meet two of three of the following criteria:

1. Earn a cumulative 3.0 grade point average (GPA) based on the SC Uniform Grading Policy (UGP) upon high school graduation
2. Score an 1100 on the SAT or an equivalent 24 on the ACT
3. Rank in the top 30% of the graduating class

(Life Scholarships are awarded at the end of the Senior Year through the Financial Aid office of your college.)

Palmetto Fellows receive up to \$6,700 their first/freshman year. *Assuming continued eligibility, eligible sophomores, juniors and seniors receive up to \$7,500 per year.*

Palmetto Fellows Scholarship Enhancement, students receive up to \$10,000 (\$7,500 Palmetto Fellows Scholarship award combined with additional \$2,500 Enhancement funds) *per year.*

(Two opportunities to earn the Palmetto Fellows Award. Both are filed through your homeschool association on your behalf.)

Palmetto Fellows Early Awards Deadline: December 15th annually

Students may apply if they meet one of the following sets of academic requirements (students cannot use the early awards criteria to be eligible for the final awards):

1. **Score at least 1200 on the SAT (27 on the ACT) by the November Test Date, earn a minimum 3.50 cumulative GPA on the SC Uniform Grading Policy (UGP) at the end of the junior year, and rank in the top six percent of the class at the end of either their sophomore or junior year;**

OR

2. **Score at least 1400 on the SAT (32 on the ACT) and earn a minimum 4.00 cumulative GPA on the SC UGP at the end of the junior year.**

Palmetto Fellows Final Awards Deadlines: June 15th annually

High school seniors may apply if they meet one of the following sets of academic requirements:

1. **Score at least 1200 on the SAT (27 on the ACT) by the June Test Date of the senior year; earn a minimum 3.50 cumulative GPA on the SC UGP at the end of the senior year; and, rank in the top six percent of the class at the end of the junior or senior year;**

OR

2. **Score at least 1400 on the SAT (32 on the ACT) by the June test administration and earn a minimum 4.00 cumulative GPA on the SC UGP at the end of the senior year.**
