DESCRIPTION: SABO was a Southern California bow company co-founded by Lyle Shannon, who also served as the head bowyer. SABO produced high-end target and hunting recurves, including the innovative SSR target bow with a shoot through riser. This fairly rare Hunter model oozes quality from tip to tip. Beautiful riser that is well balanced. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in great condition. Two (2) professionally filled screw holes on the face of the riser (see pic on last page). No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in very good shape. If you are looking for a high quality longer hunting bow in a higher draw weight, this would be a great choice.

This is a 63" bow. If you don't get a custom 63" string, you should use a 64" with several twists. A 62" string makes the brace height too high.
