Jeff Bixler– Water at Fire Dept. is a different color again already. He suggested using cistern water for showers, dishes, etc.. and keep well water for washing trucks and bays. Also, there is a 2 ft or so hole in parking lot of Fire Station. It is currently roped off. Discussion regarding a drain tile beneath the asphalt where the hole is located. Jeff will look into cost of utilizing existing cistern and bypassing softener to hopefully eliminate future water issues and reduce expense of softener salt used for bay and truck washing etc...
