The Boyertown Teachers in the Park (TIPS) Program hosted students completing kindergarten through third grade for a six week program this summer.

The TIPS program was designed to take kids out of the classroom during the summer months and bridge the summer slide gap. Students at the Boyertown Community Park worked on their Reading, Fluency and Comprehension skills, while enjoying the park as their classroom. Students also journaled while enhancing their writing skills.

Students attending the Bally location worked on their Reading and Math Skills using science to deliver the concepts.

Read and Ride Bikes are Ready for Use in Both Middle Schools:

The Boyertown Middle School Libraries each received two cycle desks through a grant from the Foundation for Boyertown Educa-tion. This grant was made possible through the generosity of community and business donors. The student pictured attends Middle School East and uses the bikes daily.

The bikes are used most during 10th period. where the bikes are used the most; however, when teachers bring their classes to the library, students often like to read and ride. The bikes are used throughout the school day by students in 6th, 7th and 8th grades.

The cycle desks give the students the opportunity to work, read, and study while exercis-ing. Movement enhances learning and im-proves mental alertness. This is a way that our students can keep fit while working and not distract other students in the library.

Pennsylvania Philharmonic performs for Boyertown Students:

The Phil Harmonic performed for students attending both Middle School East and West, as well as fifth grade classes from all elementary schools.
