

2 part First Aid/CPR/AED Training for rural Winnebago-Boone Farm Bureau Members

The training will include an on-line portion to be completed prior to the classroom time. Proof of completion is required to participate in the classroom portion and to receive certification.

**Deadline to sign up
is February 12th.**

The First Aid training will teach the participants to identify and respond to common sudden illnesses such as fainting, seizures, strokes, allergic reactions, poisoning, bleeding, fractures, diabetes and more. The CPR/AED training will include how to respond to cardiac and breathing emergencies. Participants that complete the course will receive a two-year certificate.

Farm Bureau members and family members (12 years and up) are eligible for the class. (Children 12-17 years old must be accompanied by an adult.) Cost per person is \$50.00 per person (\$50 Savings). Information on how to access the online course (approximately 2 hours) will be emailed to participants once registration is received. Registration deadline is February 12th.

Participants will need to bring proof of completion of the online course to the classroom portion on Saturday,



February 27th in order to participate. Classroom size is limited to 10 people per hour (minimum of 8 people required). The first class will begin at 9 a.m. on February 27th.
